They discussed the plan of organizing special camp at St. George A. U. P School, Pulpally. The plan and its utility were appreciated by the members and they agreed for the camp to be organized. On 21/12/2022 a meeting as conducted at St. George A U P School for forming welcome committee for the camp. It was decided to start the camp from 25<sup>th</sup> December. School authorities have requested us to create a vegetable garden, flower garden and ward member has requested us to clean the nearby areas near to school premises. After the confirmation was made, a meeting with NSS volunteers was called. In this meeting a brief presentation was made to the volunteers and plan for the camp was discussed. The volunteers excitingly participated in the discussion and planned the roadmap for camp along with guided supervision of Programme Officer. Finally a week long plan for the special camp was chocked out which was as follow:

Following are the expatiated day by day report on the seven days camp activities.

### **DAY I- (25/12/2022)**

for their support. After lunch, by 2 pm valedictory function of the fruitful seven days camp started. Camp evaluation was also conducted by the volunteers.

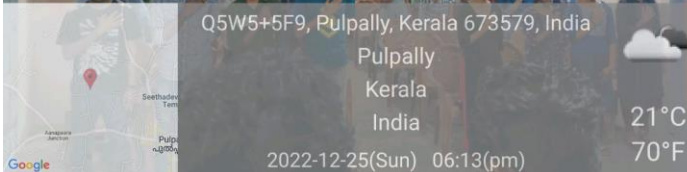

For the remembrance of camp days, the students have planted a jack fruit tree in the campus premises.

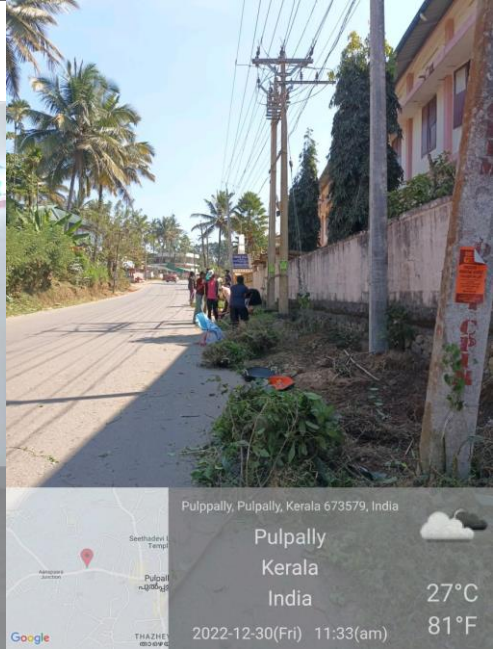
Volunteers were very happy and thankful for unique experience. Volunteers took enthusiastic hard work during the whole seven days, making the special camp a grant success.

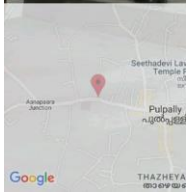
