

the seminar, yoga practice session was conducted for our students. 57 students have attended the session.




On june 22, 2022 a seminar was organised as part of world elder abuse awareness day. The

by Ms. Mubashira P M, department of microbiology has won the prize.

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

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

protecting the environment and ozone. 17 students of our college has participated the event and they collected sweets cover from college premises.






• On 17th September, as part of prabodhan programme, 4 volunteers have gone to karimbanmoola colony and priyadarshini colony to conduct classes for tribal students.






On 29th November, 2022 NSS units of our college organised a ANTI DRUG AWARENESS

December 2022



REPORT OF NSS SPECIAL CAMP 2022-23

DATE: 25-12-22 TO 31-12-22



DAY 1- (25/12/2022)

The commencement day of the camp began at 10 am with registration. All camp members were directed to make arrangements for the seven days camp, which continued till 1 pm. 
