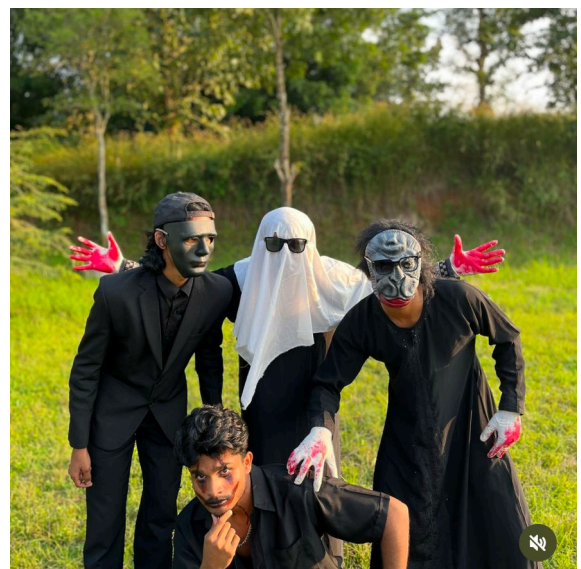

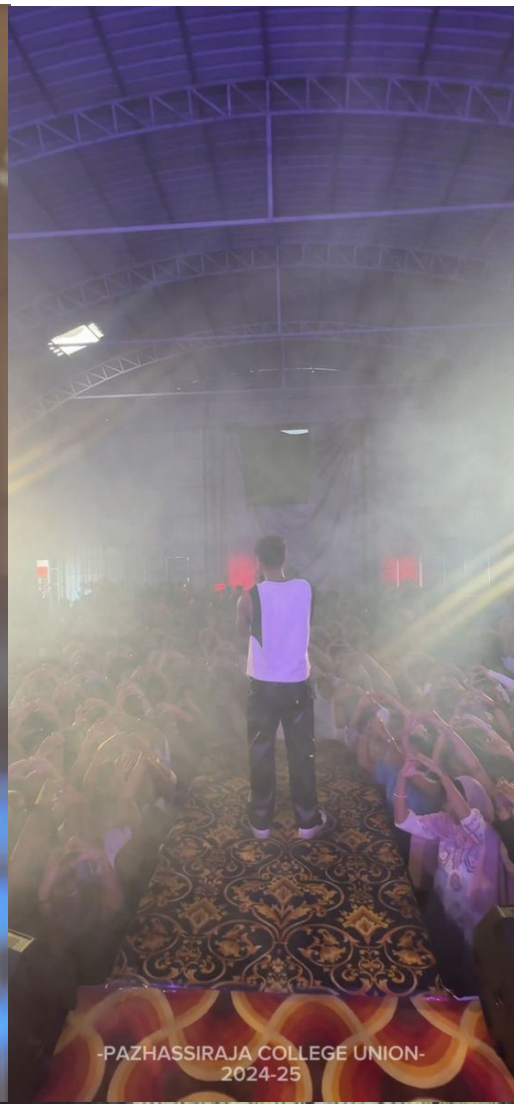

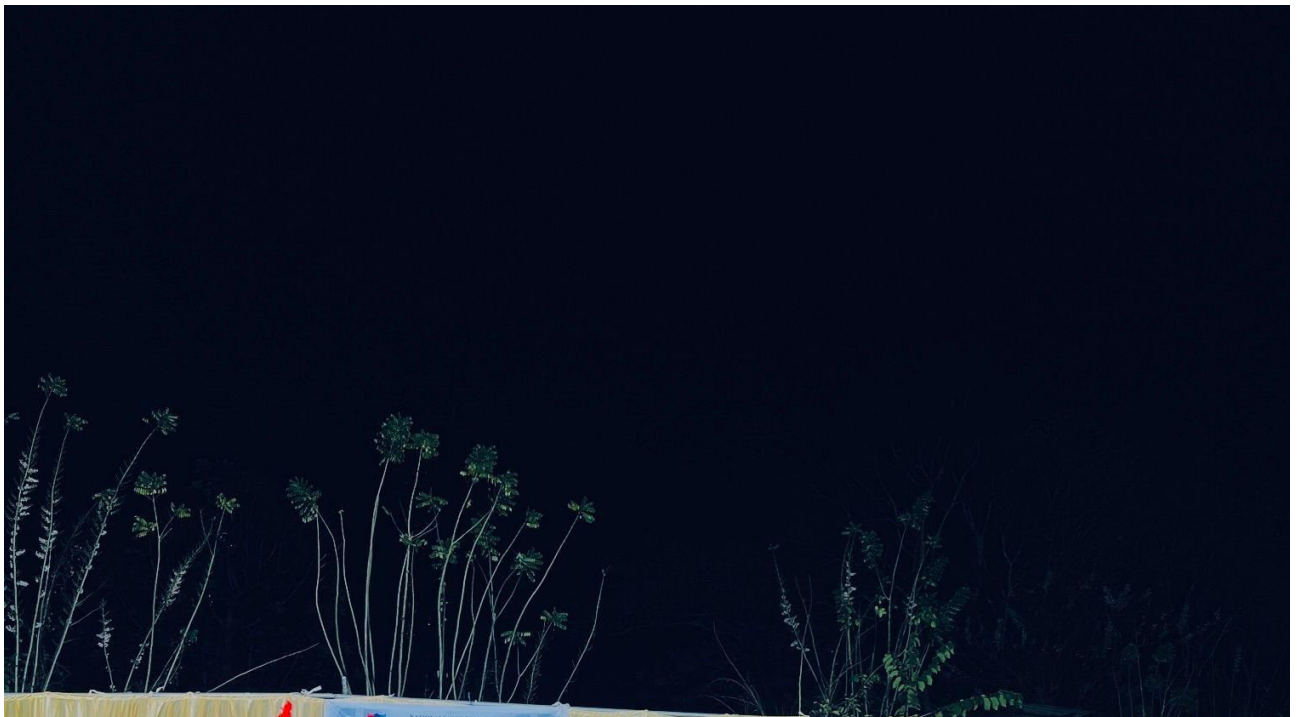


NCC Cadets Felicitation **Ceremony**

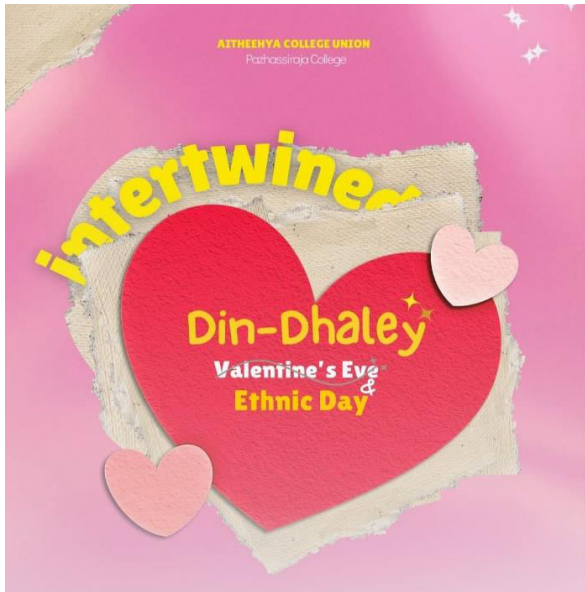

Programme Highlights

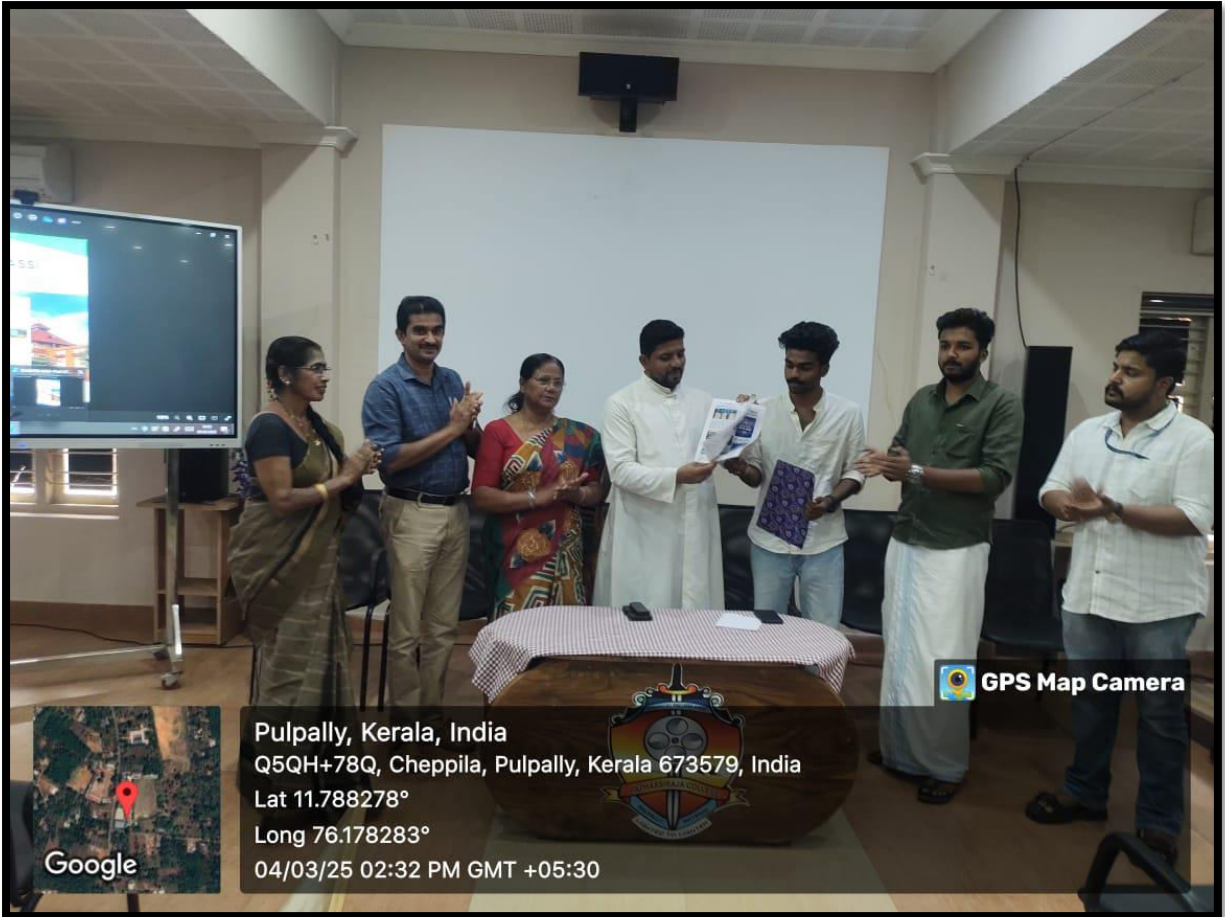

Programme Objectives

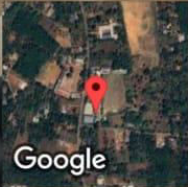
1. **Document and Showcase Events** – To compile and publish news about the various programs and initiatives undertaken by the College Union.
