1. To aware the students about the dignity and respect of women


2. To give an orientation to the students about women and child protection laws





WEBINAR: GENDER BIAS IN INDIAN ADVERTISEMENTS

Introduction to the Programme

The Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, Pazhassiraja College organised a session on "Gender bias in Indian advertisements, in association with the Women Development Cell. Ms. Sruthi CR, Doctoral Scholar, Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Kannur University was invited to speak in the webinar on the topic, Gender Bias in Indian advertisements. The session was on Google meet, and more than 50 students from both the post graduate and undergraduate wings of the Mass Communication department actively attended the session.

Objectives of the session

The session had the following objectives

1. To initiate the media students towards the gender disparity that is prevalent in the Indian advertising scenario.

- 2. To orient media students to develop independent thinking beyond gender concerns.
- 3. To iron out gender bias while developing content for advertising.

Description The session started with the introductory remarks and welcome address by Dr. Jobin Joy, Faculty, Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, Pazhassiraja College. The session was presided over by Dr. Anilkumar K, Principal, Pazhassiraja College. He gave a detailed picture of the present market scenario by drawing relevant examples from the industry. He also cited inferences from the recent research studies conducted in this field. Dr. Merin S Thadathil, Convener, women cell, felicitated the event by giving a thoughtful speech.

Ms Sruthy, the speaker of the webinar, oriented our students on the gender disparities that are visible in Indian Advertisements which are often ignored or unnoticed. She cited relevant examples from prominent television advertisements. She spoke on the gender stereotyping scenario where women are portrayed for certain jobs, like giving baths to kids, washing plates, cleaning toilets, cooking etc. She also pointed out there are certain exceptions to this situation where all genders are treated equally. The session was highly interactive. More than 50 students from the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism attended the session. Many students raised their concerns regarding the topic of discussion and the speaker was able to clarify their doubts by citing relevant instances. The session was highly interactive and informative.







2. To ensure women can own property, vote, get paid fair wages, and live free from violence


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
