teaching assistants. The delegation also consisted of students Bothaina Almohamady, Karim Wael, and Hagar Mohamed. An interactive session was organised at the col-

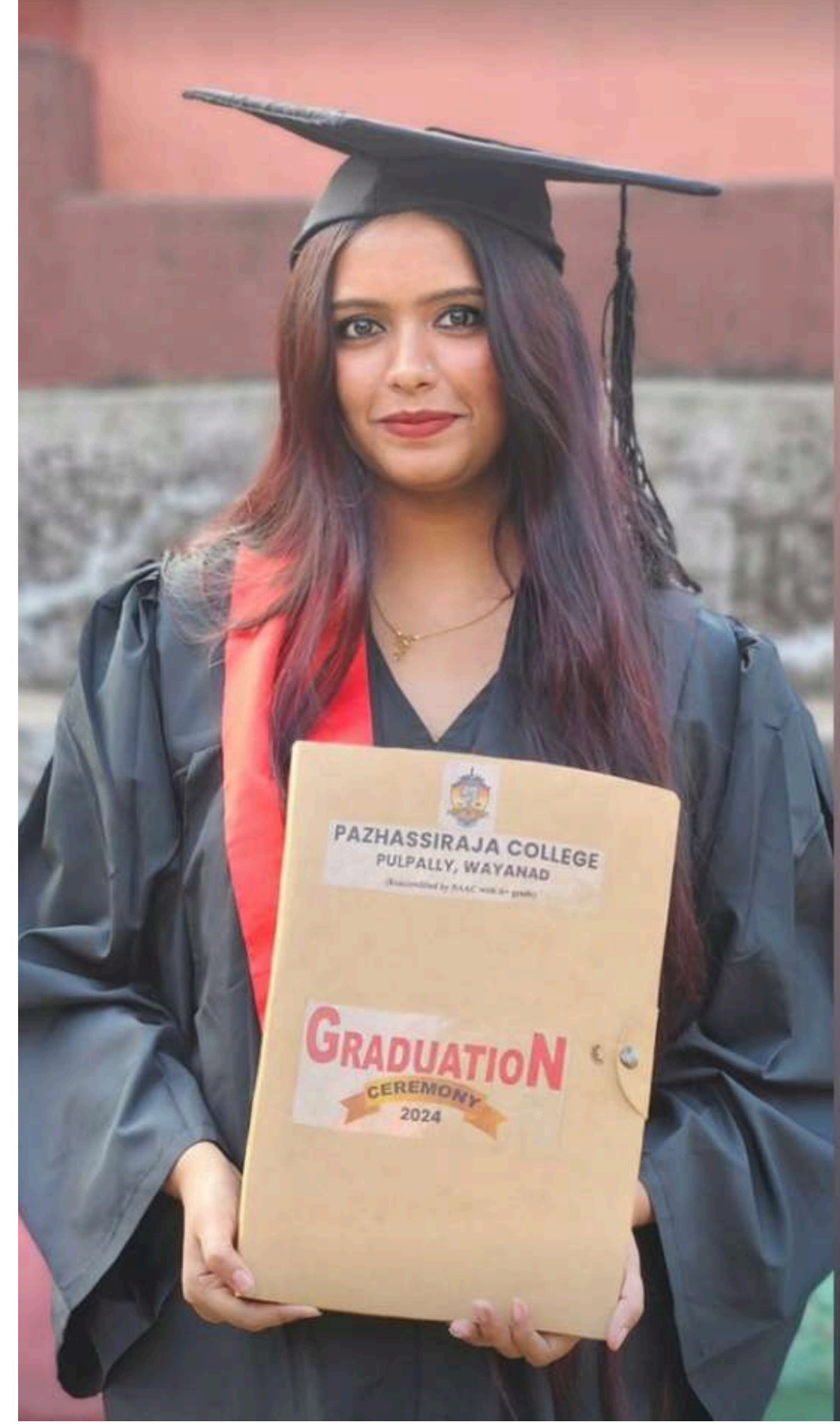
