IQAC has submitted the SSR successfully by the end of JANUARY 2022.

In order to make a comprehensive course planner which includes all the relevant documents, Comprehensive Course Planner (CCP) was introduced. Course planning, implementation and achievement of outcomes were monitored effectively. Orientation and bridge courses were done for the fresh batches.

Even if there were uncertainties, student centric learning and experiential learning efforts were implemented efficiently. Feedback collection and analysis was effectively done.

It was ensured that the infrastructure expansion plan was done successfully. Class room construction, library expansion, sports centre expansion and ramp renovation was almost completed.

Learning Management System (LMS): MOODLE was experimentally initiated.

Other online tools like Google Classroom, Edmodo, Google Meet, Zoom, Gmail, Telegram and Duo are used for ensuring online learning.

Institutional email id created for all students and they are encouraged to use it for sending the drafts of Assignments and Projects to minimize the use of hard copy printouts.

Inflibnet and NList were provided to students for accessing materials online.

Multiple Digital Resource Sharing Platforms are offered including YouTube channel, Teacher Parent Communication Application (ERP) of the college, QR code, FB group, FB live, Google Drive, Learning Apps, like Byju's App, Website, Open Broadcast Service (OBS), Creative Commons, College Website, and bookwidget.com. E library is offered to students.

IT equipped Classrooms: Approximately half of the classroom are with LCD projectors, and efforts were taken to ensure Wi-Fi connectivity in all classrooms.
