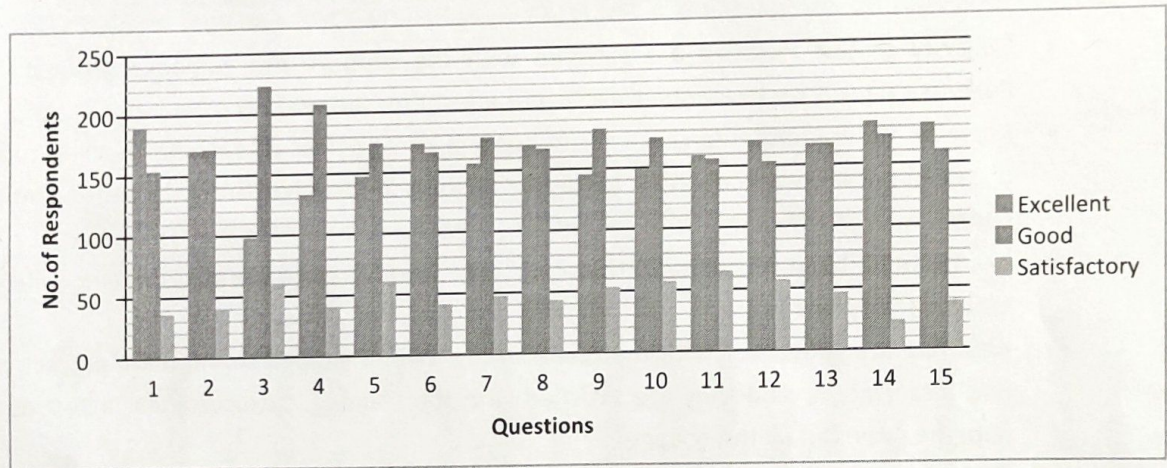

FEEDBACK ANALYSIS OF CURRICULUM DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION

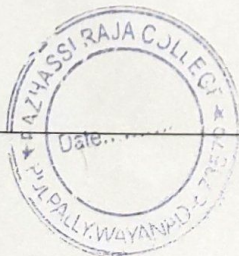
ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS - 2022-23

The results were analyzed in the IQAC meeting held on **02.0.2023**

For the majority of the questions, the respondents expressed highest level of satisfaction. While the colleges involvement in the curriculum setting is limited, the faculty members strive to disseminate the curriculum effectively. General suggestions are forwarded to BoS.

- Majority of the alumnae are satisfied with the support and guidance given by the Pazhassiraja college to pursue their higher education successfully.
- Most of the respondents says we are good in using ICT as a teaching learning tool to disseminate the curriculum in a way to acquire knowledge from simple to complex concepts.
- Ex- students have the opinion that course delivery enabled them to enhance life and employability skill.
- Alumnae are contented with the research capabilities shaped through the project work and dissertation. And they are satisfied with the training, extracurricular activities and support provided by the college
- Alumni believe that the evaluation system, participatory and student-centered learning and remedial system was highly effective.

- The teaching learning methods and the student teacher relationship are showcased the excellence of the teachers in the college. It is revealed through the opinion of the majority of the ex- students.



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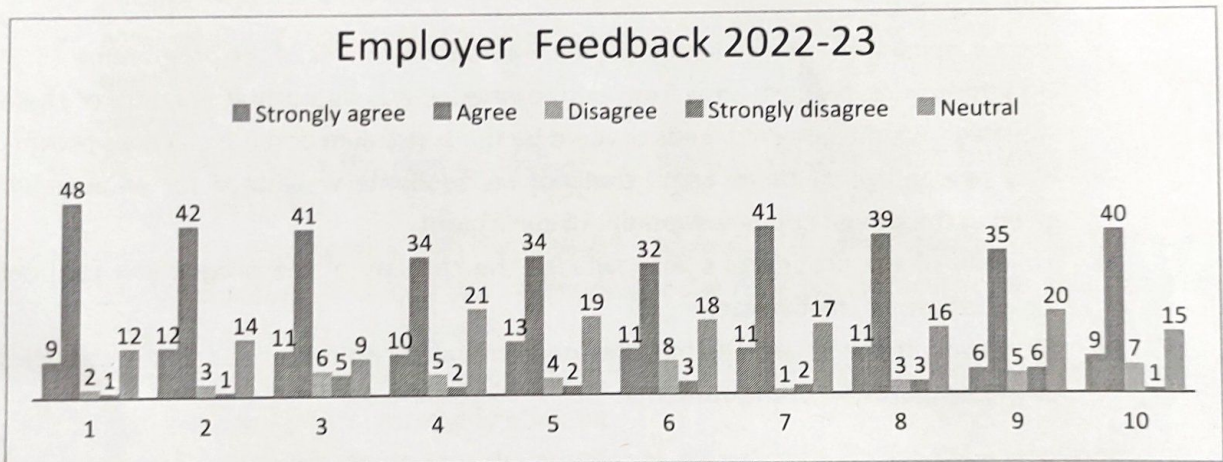
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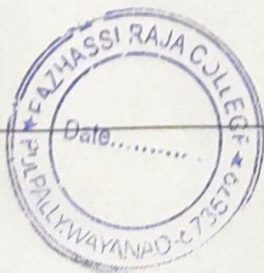
EMPLOYER FEEDBACK ANALYSIS - 2022-23

For the academic year 2022-23, the feedback on curriculum of the different programmes of the college were collected from employer and analysed by IQAC. Analysis of the feedback given by the employers revealed the vital information.

The employer feedback forms consist of 10 questions and the number of responses were 72.

The results were analyzed in the IQAC meeting held on **02.0.2023**

- Employers agreed with the comment that students are competent and the curriculum promotes innovative thinking
- Employers acknowledge the capacity of the programme in producing problem cracking temperament and the ability to innovate in their teams
- Employers are comfortable with the soft skills given by the curriculum and institution
- Moreover, it is recognized that the programme offered are enriched with the recent developments.
- In their opinion the curriculum is aligned with the objectives of the programme
- On interpreting the response from entrepreneurs, it is noted that majority of them are satisfied with the current trends covered by the curriculum and the electives provided.
- Fifty percentage of them admit that not an adequate weightage for employability is given in the design and development of curriculum
- Majority of the proprietor's acknowledge the capacity of the programme to meet the expectations of the industry
- Moreover, it is recognized that the programmes offered by the college enhances the entrepreneur skills of the students.



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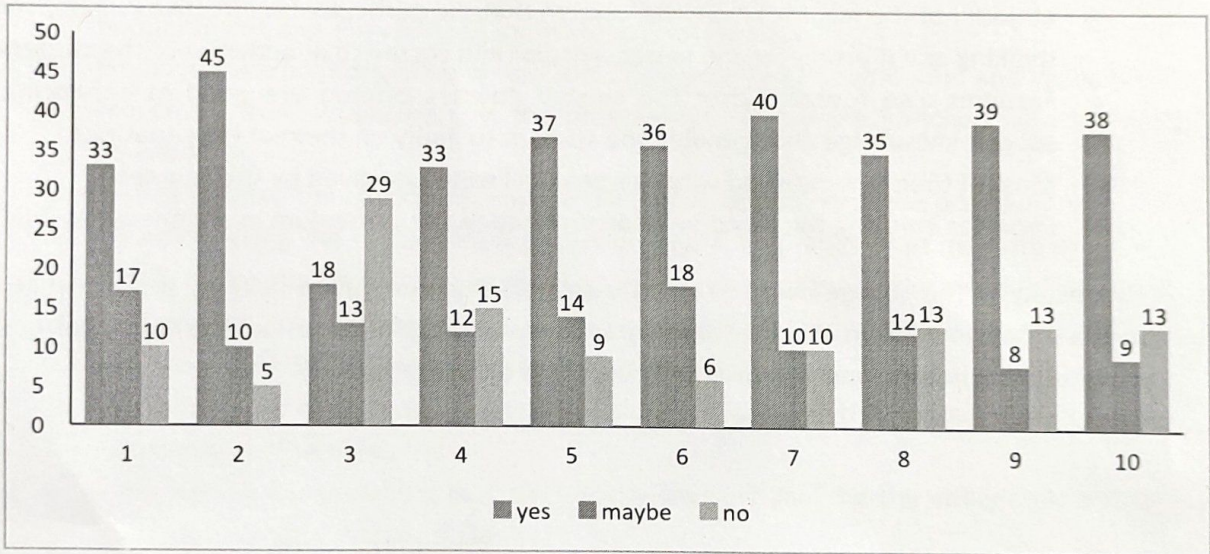
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FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

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FACULTY FEEDBACK ANALYSIS - 2022-23

For the academic year 2022-23, the feedback on academic performance and ambience of the college were collected from faculty and analysed by IQAC. A total of 60 responses were received.

Feedback Analysis Report

The results were analyzed in the IQAC meeting held on 02.03.2023

- Most of the faculties are contented with the research inclusive learning of the curriculum.
- It is also noted that there is a clarity in course objectives and learning outcomes
- The faculty of the college had concrete perceptions on curriculum development, but they don't have much opportunities to involve in the process of curriculum design. Instead, they propose their suggestions through the inhouse BoS members.
- Majority of the faculties have the opinion that the curriculum is effective in independent thinking and it promotes the extracurricular and cocurricular activities of the students
- Faculties also revealed that the current courses offered are good in enhancing the subject knowledge and it enable the student to apply on the real-life situations.
- Most of them are satisfied with the practical exposure given by the courses.
- Faculties enjoying the freedom in disseminating the curriculum in an innovative way

The faculty of the college had expressed their vision on curriculum delivery process in general suggestions provided in the feedback form. They pointed out the importance of introducing more carrier oriented and skill-oriented certificate courses.



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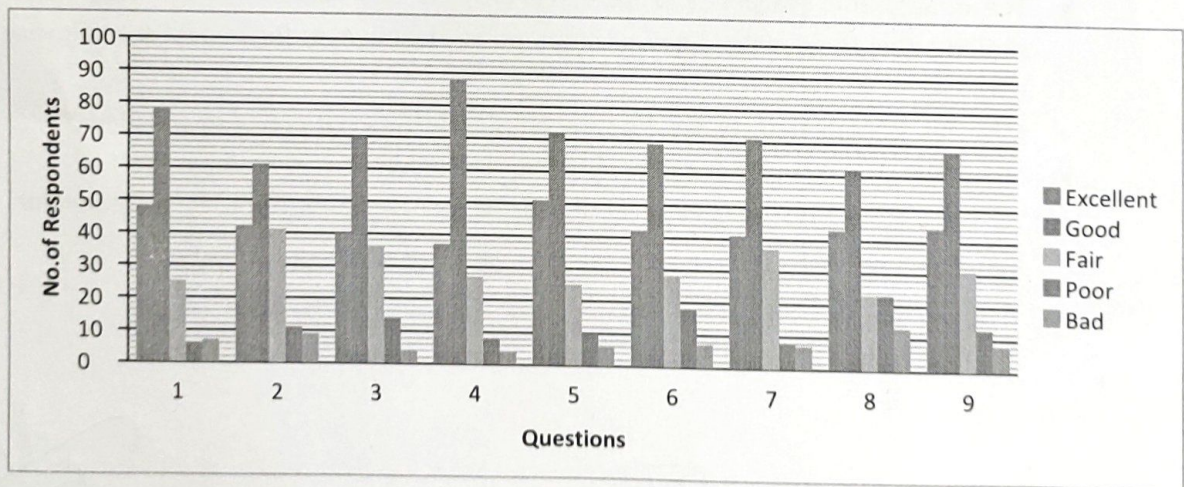
FEEDBACK ANALYSIS OF CURRICULUM DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION

STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS - 2022-23

The feedback was collected as part of the ongoing quality assurance efforts of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The analysis aims to identify areas of strength and areas for improvement to enhance the overall quality of education provided by the institution. Student feedback was collected through google forms distributed to all currently enrolled students during the 2022-23. The survey included questions covering various dimensions such as teaching quality, curriculum relevance, infrastructure, student support services, and overall satisfaction. A total of 164 responses were received.

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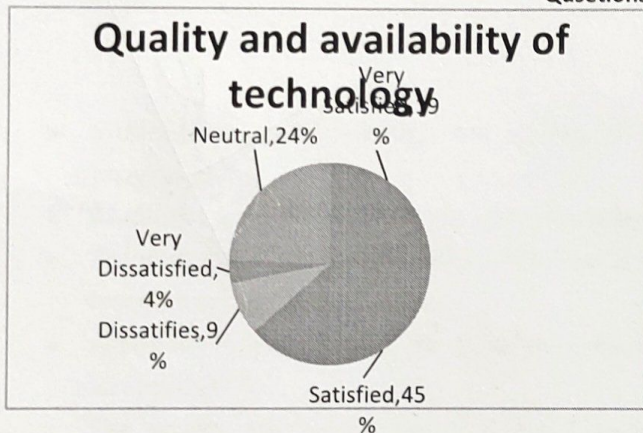
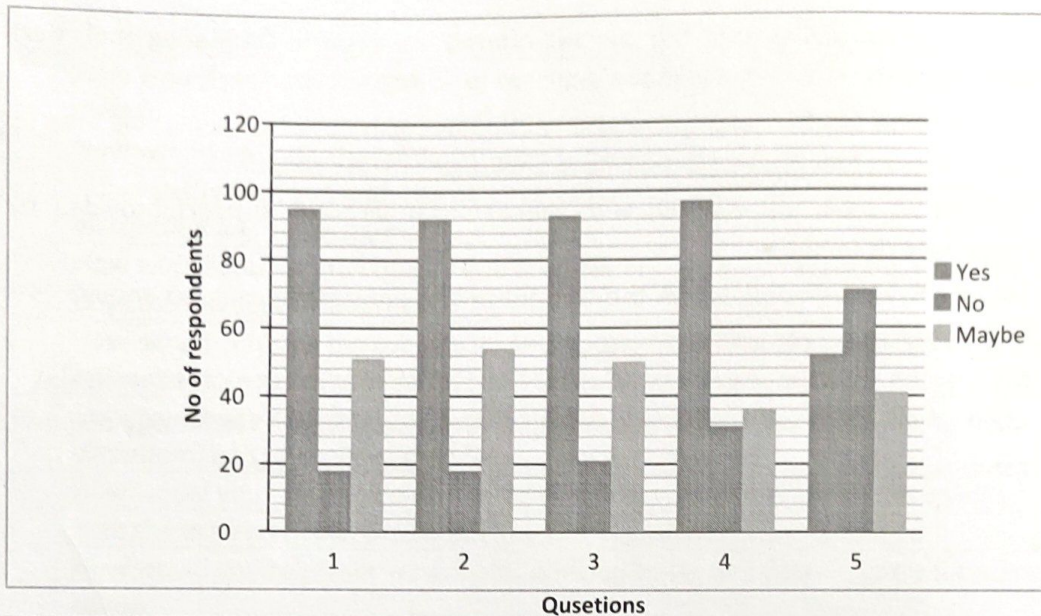

- Students are expressed their level of satisfaction over opportunities in connection with the arts and sports



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
