

Outcomes of the visit:

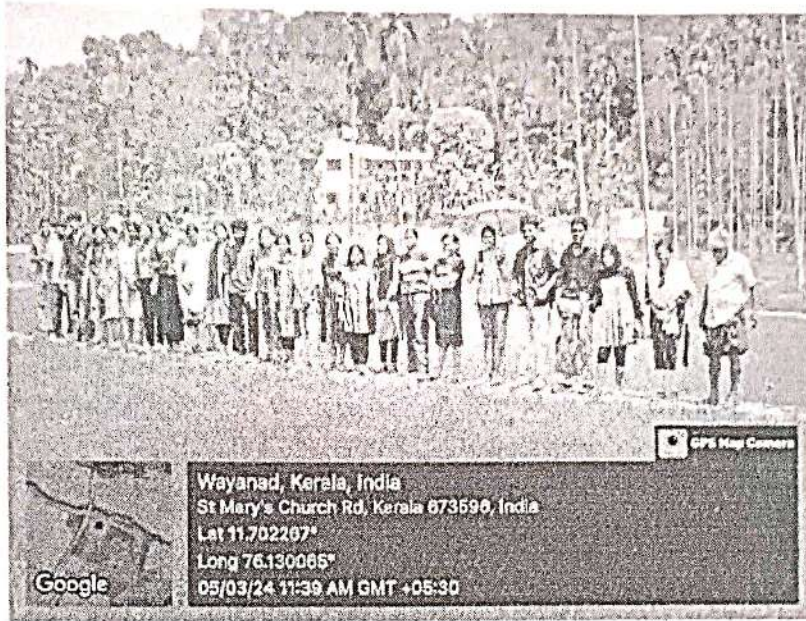
The students overall gained a basis idea about the rice cultivation

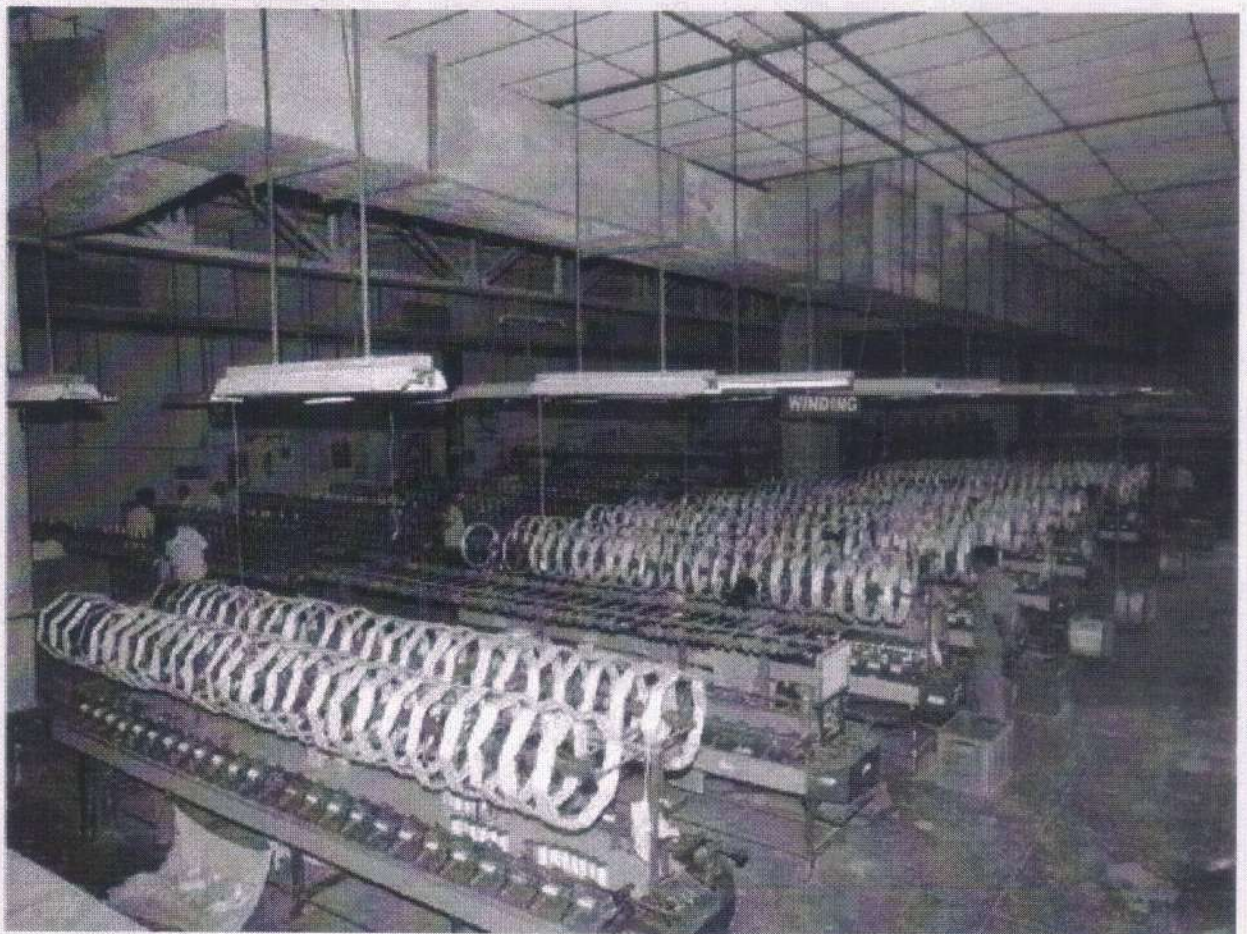

All the students had assembled at around 8 AM at Perikallur and departure to Mysore was at 8.30 AM. The destination was reached at 11.30AM.

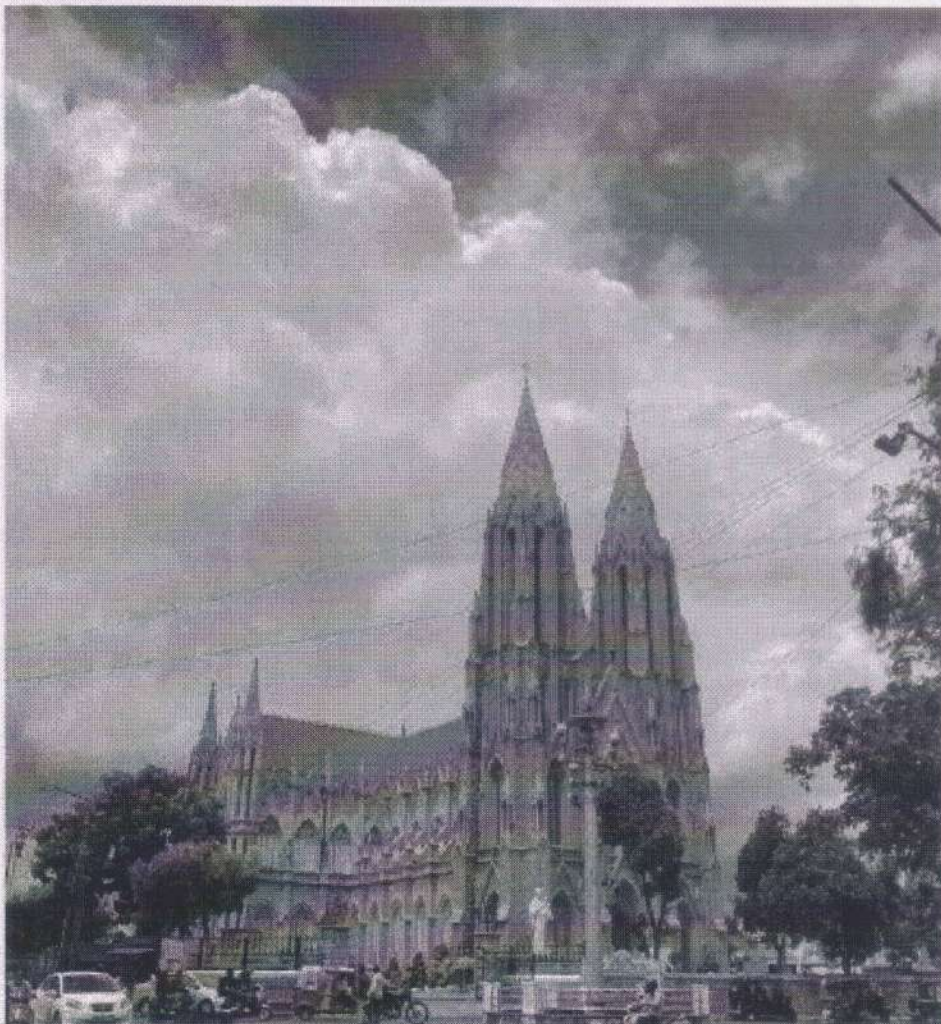

At 2.45 PM, Lunch was arranged near the cathedral. After having lunch, at 3.15 PM we left for Srirangapatna.

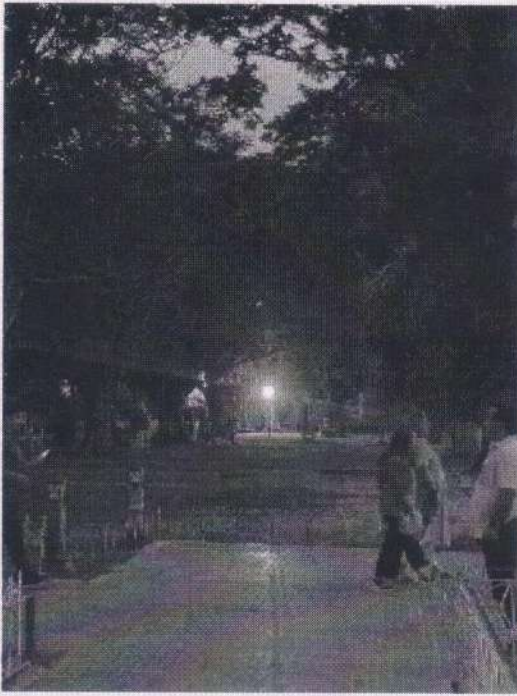

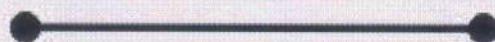
**At 5.45 PM we reached Krishna Raja Sagara Dam,

Day 1 - November 23rd, 2023:

CSTRI Mysore Visit: The day commenced with a visit to CSTRI (Central Silk Technological Research Institute) in Mysore. Dr. Muthulakshmi, scientist in the field, elaborated on the intricate processes involved in silk production and the researches going on. The students were exposed to the mulberry plantation and gained insights into silk worm production, witnessing the lifecycle and stages of silk production first-hand.

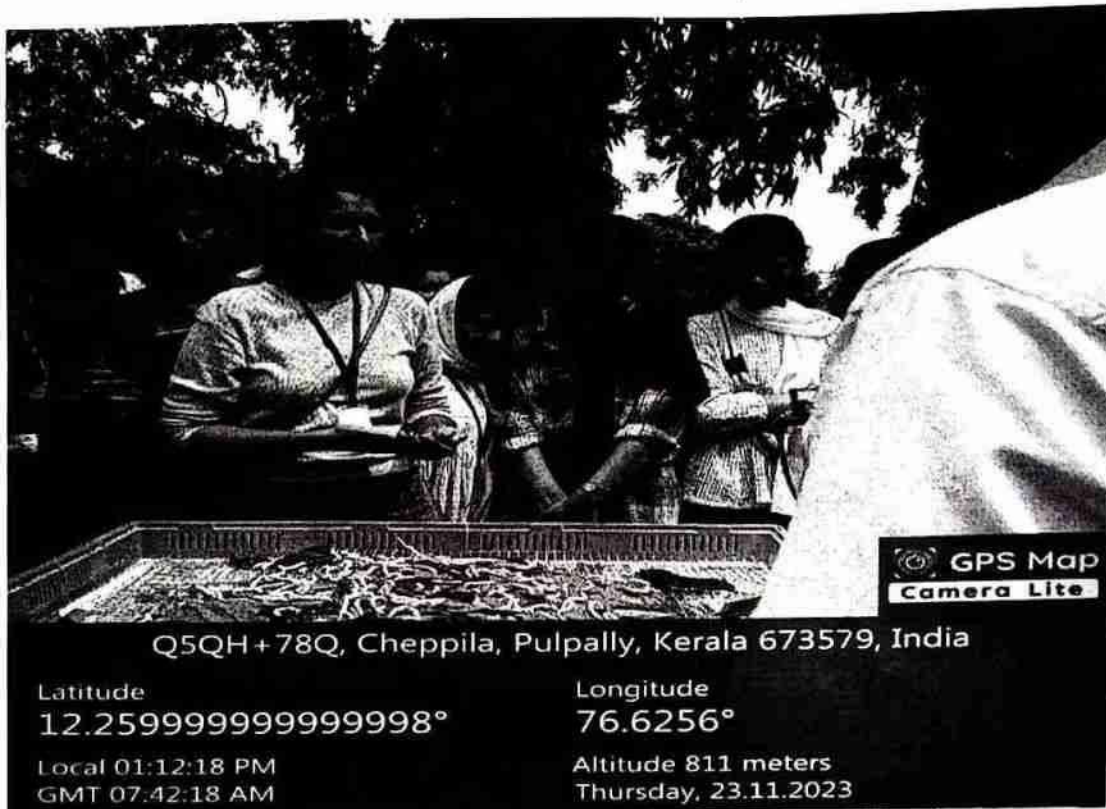
Central Sericulture Research and Training Institute

Field Visit to Vanamoolika

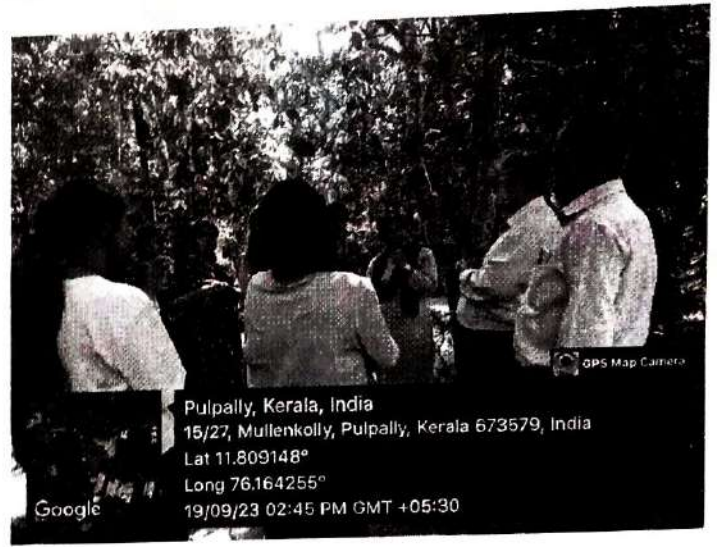
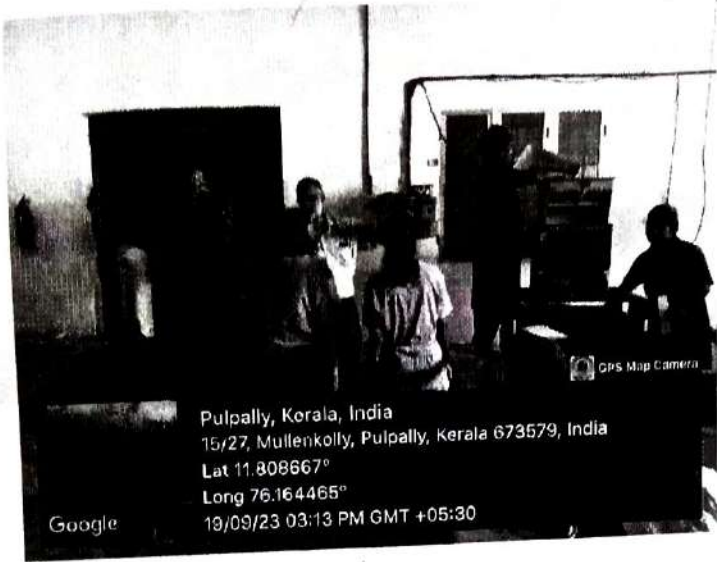

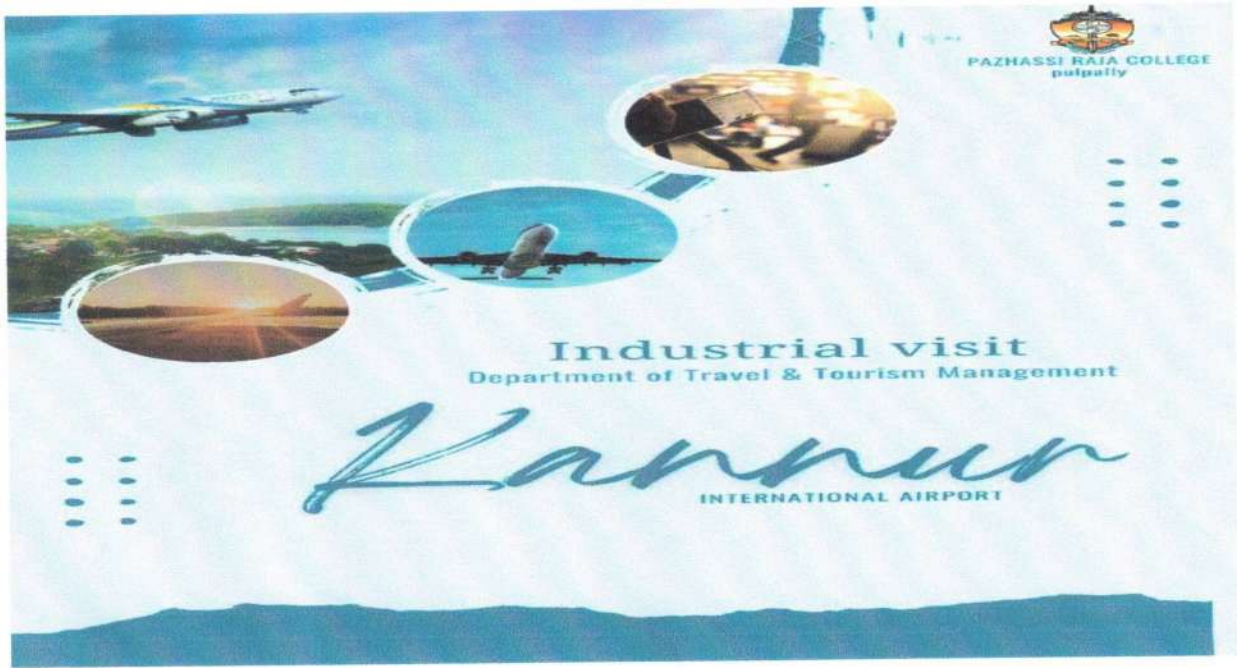
Recommendations:
