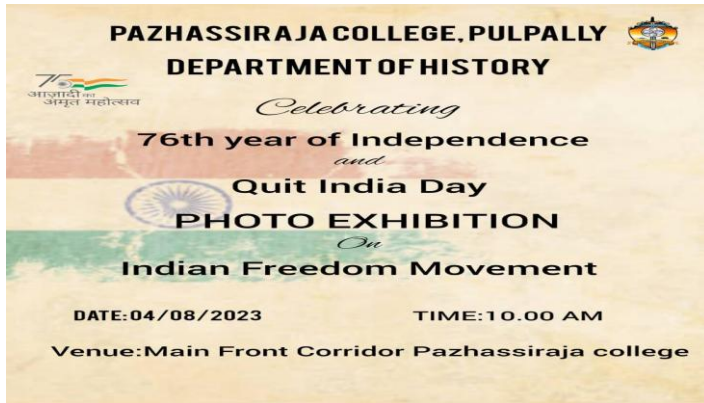

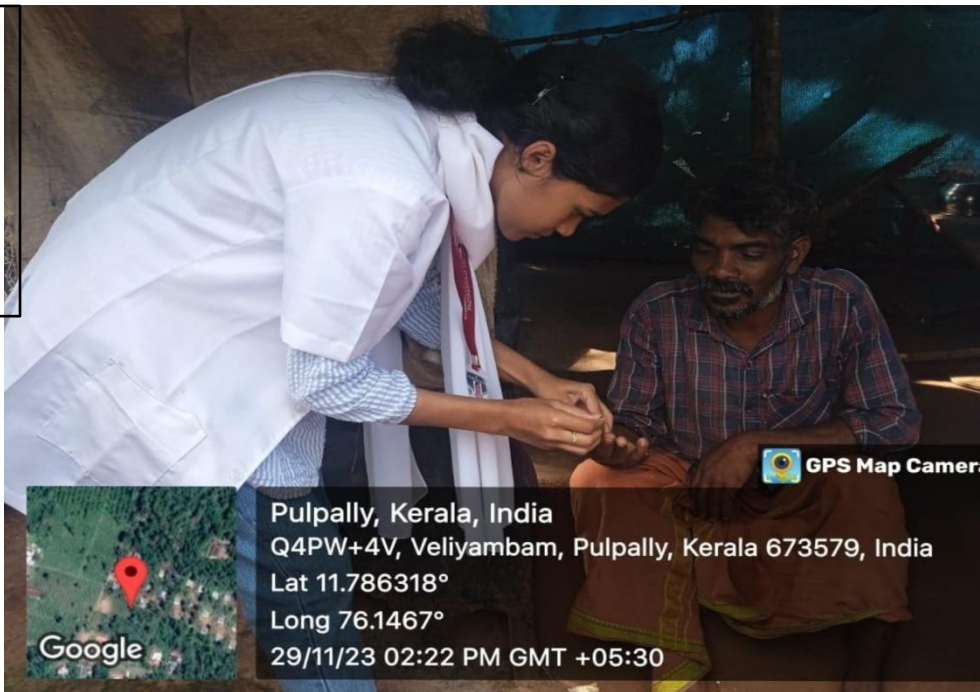

BLOOD DETECTION CAMP AT PRIYADARSHINI COLONY

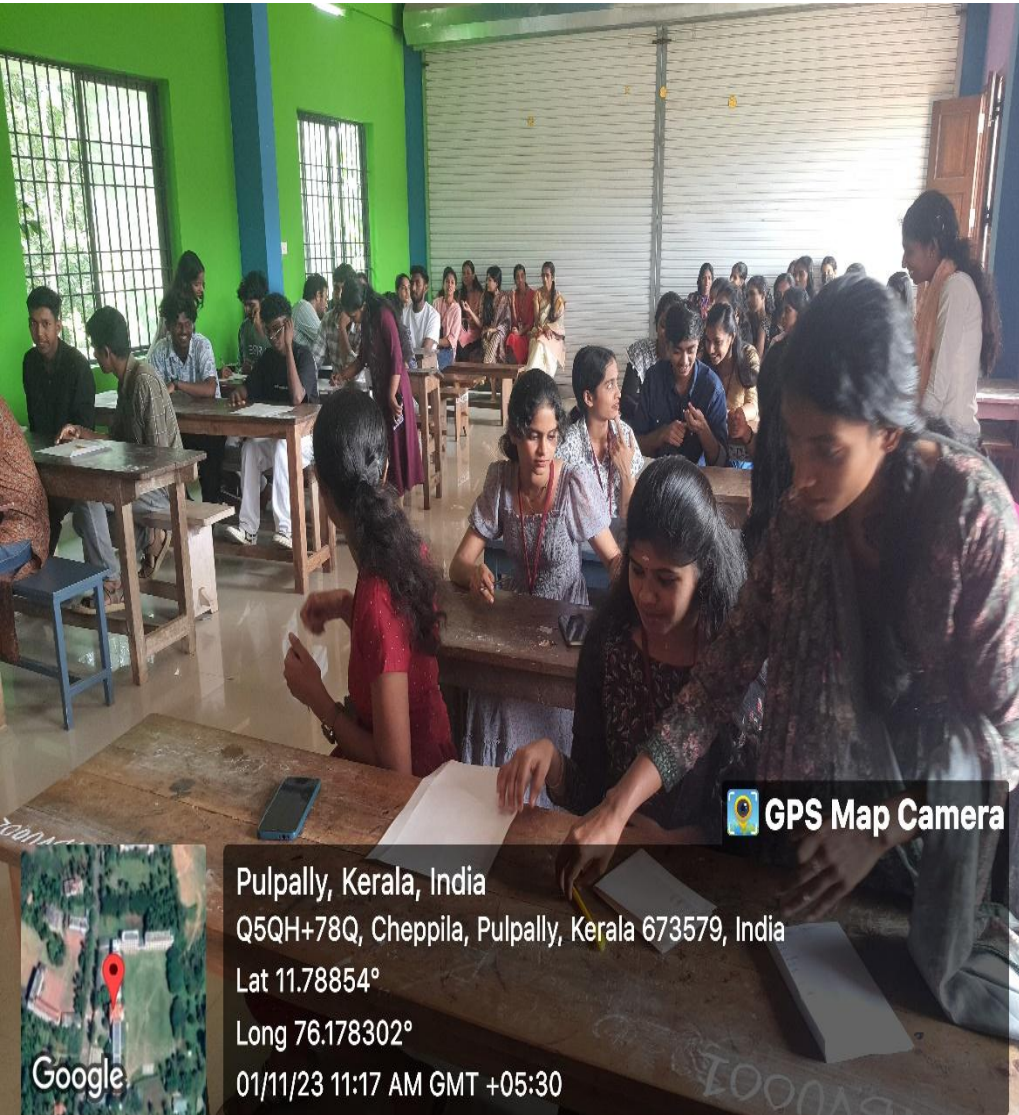
A Blood detection camp were conducted on 29/11/2023 at Priyadarshini colony. The community's diversity and cooperation made this initiative impactful.
