Objectives:

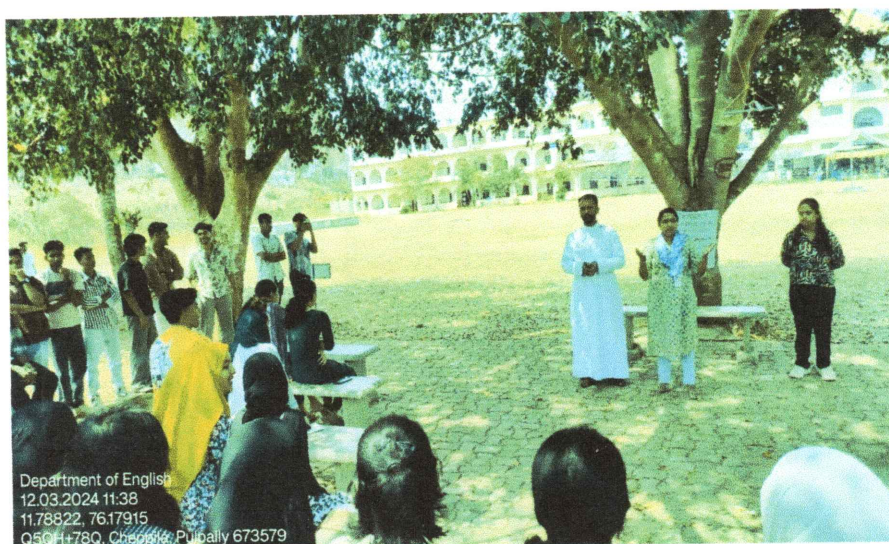
- To evaluate current gender equality metrics in various areas such as education, employment, politics, healthcare, and representation in media.

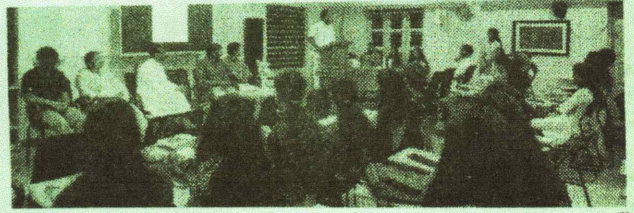
The programme named 'Jwala: Inspire 'n' Ignite – English Language Training was inaugurated on 19 August 2023. 47 students participated in the programme.

Number of Students Participated: 47

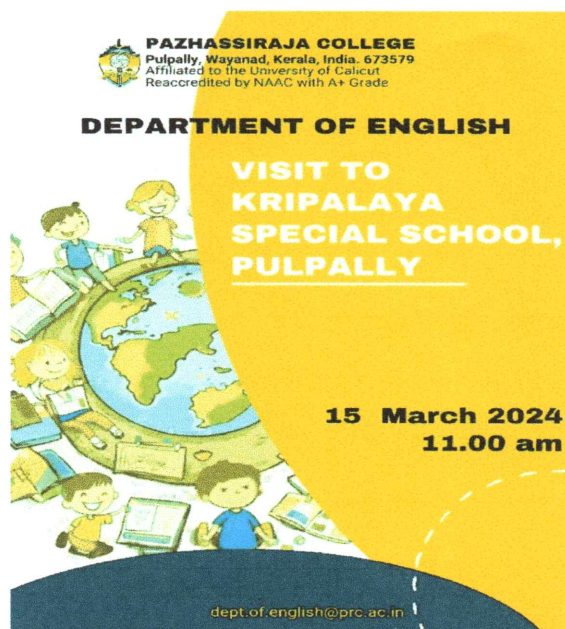
Duration: 2 hours (11 AM - 1 PM)

Observation of International Peace Day in colleges not only spreads awareness but also nurtures a culture of peace and tolerance among the future leaders and citizens of the world.



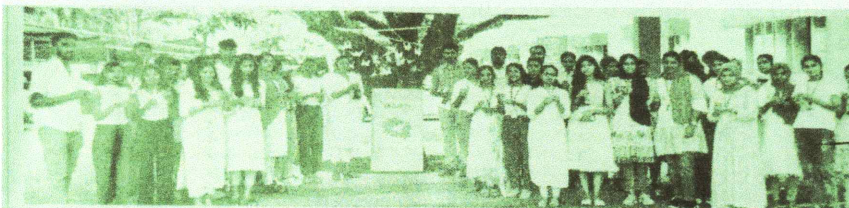
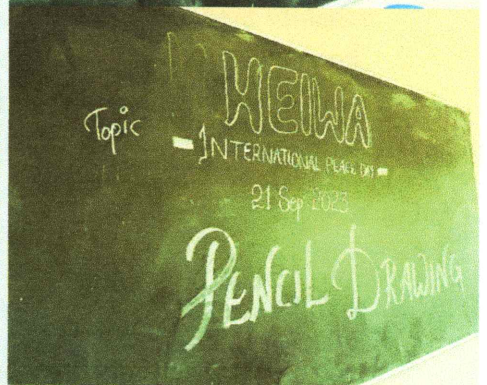
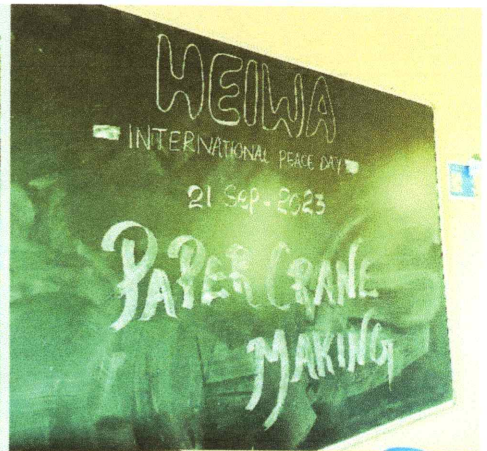

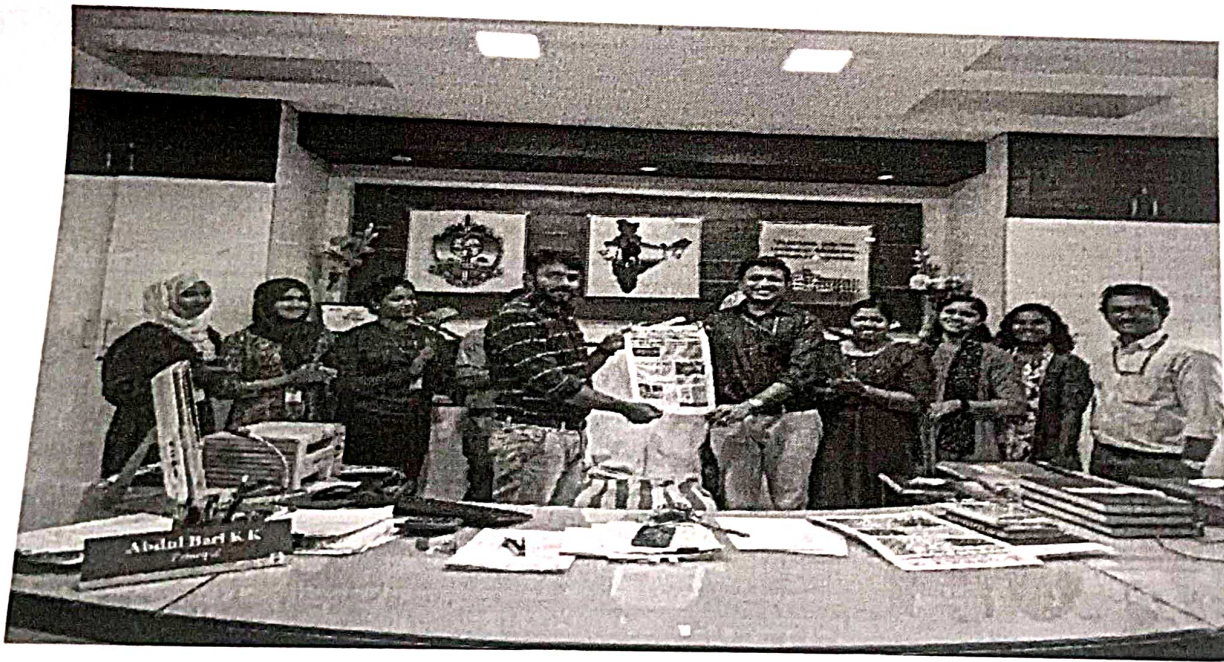
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Release of Campus Chronicle Newspaper

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
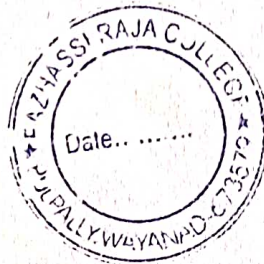
World Mosquito Day Celebration

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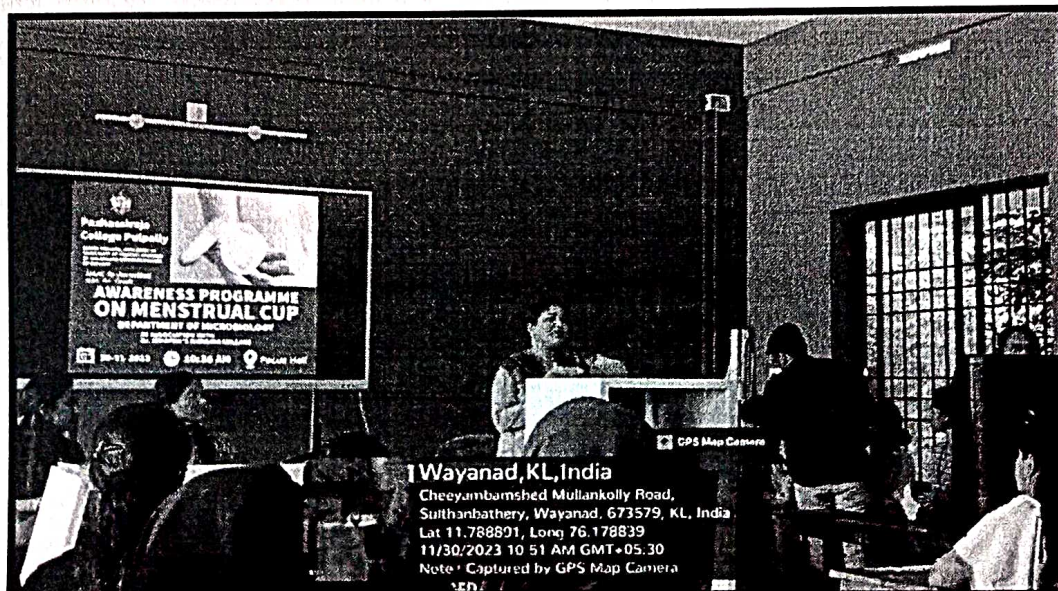


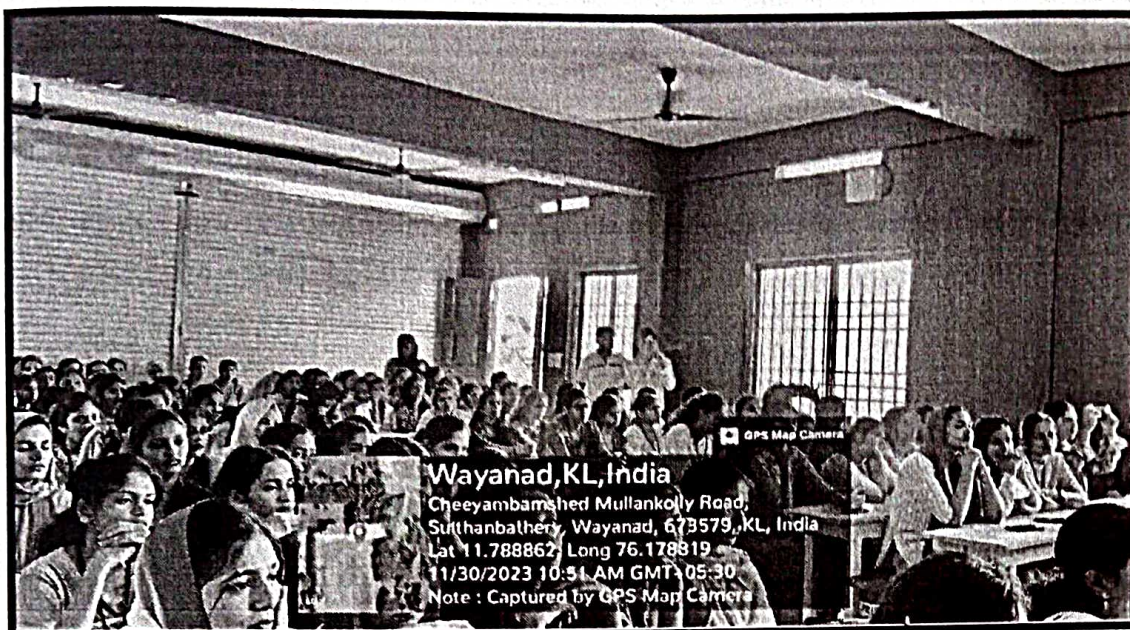
REPORT ON MENSTRUAL CUP AWARENESS PROGRAMME

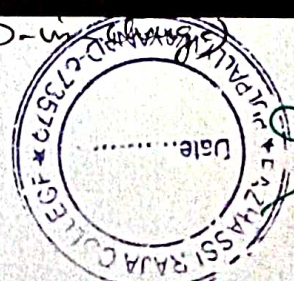
