Topic: 'PROSPECTS OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP'

The session was held on 16 December 2020 (Wednesday) on thetopic Prospects of Entrepreneurship - "Social entrepreneurship encompasses the activities andprocesses undertaken to discover, define and exploit opportunities in order to enhance socialwealth by creating new venture or managing existing organization in an innovative manner". Thesession was handled by Mr. AkhilAjith who is pursuing PhD in Agriculture Extension at KeralaAgriculture University. The session began at 2:30 p.m with a welcome speech by Ms. FingleStein. In the introduction MrAkhil described the inspiring life story of MrRiteshAgarwalwho becomes a successful entrepreneur at the age of 18 and he was the one who introduce theconcept of Oyo rooms in 2013. Though he was a college dropout, his business skills earned himcores and made him famous.

The session also gave us a clear picture the concept of entrepreneurs. The class led to adetailed discussion on the features of an entrepreneur such as Decision making, Motivation. TheMain objective of an entrepreneurship is creation of social wealth rather than economic wealth, develop skills, create employment & Foster pathways to integrate socially excluded people. Thethree-p's in entrepreneurship is planet-profit-people. Besides we were also given an idea of MSME- Micro Small and Medium Enterprise. There are two types of MSME sectors manufacture sector and service sector. EntrepreneurSupport Scheme (ESS) For General Category Assistance is 15% limited to Rs 20 lakhs. For Young (18 to 45 years), Women and SC/ST entrepreneurs,

the assistance is 20% limited to Rs 30lakhs. MSMEs started in the districts of Idukki, Wayanad, Kasaragod and Pathanamthitta areeligible for an additional support of 10% limited to Rs. 10 lakhs. Industries set up after acquiringnew technology from approved research institutions are also eligible for an additional support of 10% assistance limited to Rs. 10 lakhs. The total eligible assistance for an enterprise is limited to Rs. 30 lakh.

The next part of session was about Ed club Department of Industries & Entrepreneurship Commerce, Government of Kerala formulated schemes Development Clubs in schools and 10colleges of the State to inculcate entrepreneurial culture among youth to sensitize industrialscenario of the state, to nurture the latent entrepreneurial talent, Develop awareness among itsmembers of the attitudes, values, and skills of successful entrepreneurs around the globe etc. Agni Clinics and Agni Business Centre's (ACABC) Scheme, RKVY- RAFTAAR - Agnibusiness incubator by Kerala Agricultural University, SFAC, and NABARD & MANAGE aresupporting ecosystem of MSMEboth online and offline facilities are available. "Era of job seekers is slowly setting on the horizon. But with that comes the rise of anew era, the era of job givers". The session concluded by giving a window how to explore inAgni enterprise or with new agribusiness trends. On the whole we got an idea about Agnienterprise also about the marketing, systems schemes, supporting ecosystem of enterprise etc. We learned from this session. Throughout the session it was interesting and inspiring. Thesession followed by a vote of thanks was presented by Megha Rajesh.
