





District Tourism Promotion Council (DTPC) provided a grant to Pazhassiraja College in 2016 to support training of local people in Tour Guiding, an extension activity identified by our college.

The program's main aim is to enhance tourist experiences and to offer more professional guidance to trained local guides. Whilst Wayanad's rich cultural heritage and unique landscapes motivate most visitors both domestically and internationally, the concept of community-based biodiversity conservation offers excellent opportunities for wildlife viewing and promotion. Local people need to be educated to improve quality levels to perform more with externals and the natural guide services offered locally must be properly distributed to local and regional tour operators.

## FIELD TRAINING 30 HOURS (excluding travel)

- Should have completed classroom discussion of the visiting destination
- 43) Conducted sightseeing tours along with professional tour guides (experts) to various tourist places in Wayanad like Edakkal, Kuruvadweep, Pookote, Soochippara and Chembra, Banasurasagar, Aralam, etc.
- 44) The guide will demonstrate and infuse practical guiding skills and tips to the trainees and the trainees will, in turn demonstrate their guiding skills.
- 45) The trainees should also interact with destination management personnel as well as ancillary service providers at the visiting destination like auto/taxi drivers, eateries, curio-shops, etc at the visiting destination.
- 46) Visiting and interacting with at least one Hotel/Tourist Resort and Tour Operator / Tourist transport Agent / Travel Agency each.

## ASSISTED TOUR GUIDING/ESCORTING:

This is a key feature of the guide training programme. Each student should take up one email enquiry reaching DTPC, and process the itinerary and escort the tour whenever possible in

Wayanad, along with supervision of the course coordinator. This can be taken up towards the end of the training, after commencing of the field visit. This is not part of practical examination and is intended to give real hands-on experience and initiation of the trainee into tour guiding/escorting profession.







- Partook in the Procession held on fifth of January 2020 as part of palliative care day rally.




