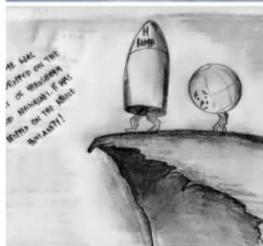
Hiroshima..
