around to this lovely planet We promise to take care of you.












WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY - 31/5/2021



Tree Planting Programme



A Helping Hand



- 5. IDY QUIZ COMPETITION- our 27 cadets took part in the online quiz on the day.





We have conducted an online speech for the awareness against drug abuse on the Day








We have also conducted a drawing competition with the theme 'Say No to Drugs' and the cadets exhibited their stand against Drugs through their canvas.

(kl/19/SDA/202847) of NMSM Govt. College, Kalpetta won the competition. Momento for the winner will be provided in formal manner, when the college reopens.




WORLD POLPULATION DAY - 11/07/2021


Webinar on Kargil War (26/07/2021)


OCTOBER MONTH - REPORT


