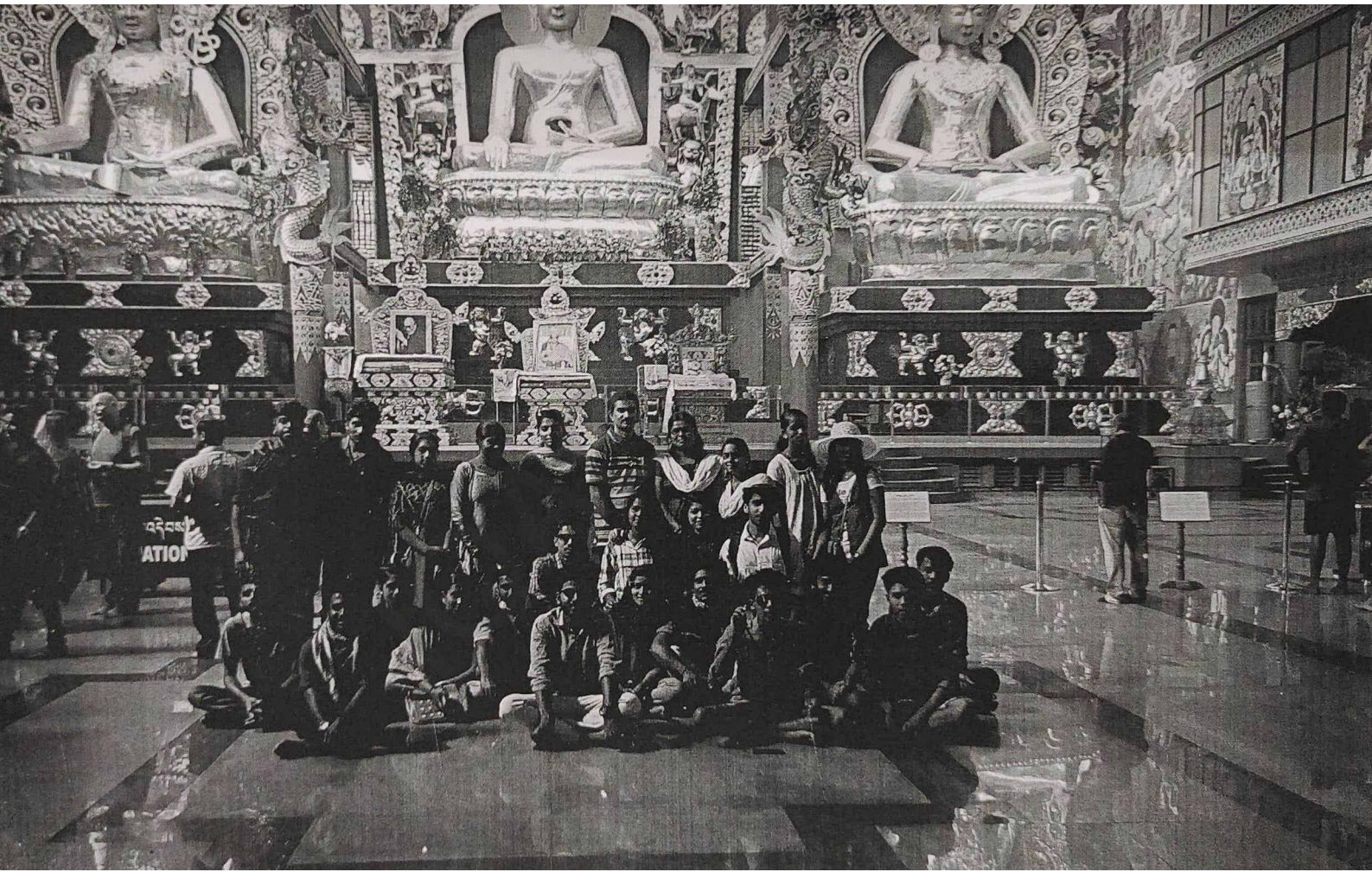

Objectives of the visit

1. To learn the different plant propagation techniques
2. To visit the nurseries, propagation structures of different crops

Outcomes of the visit

1. The students learnt the different plant propagation techniques
acquainted with the different propagating structures, nursery techniques of different crops

The department organized a visit to the Aikkara Plant Nursery, Panamaram, Wayanad on 19 March 2019. This visit was intended to give the students a hands-on experience in asexual methods of propagation in fruit trees and other horticultural crops. The students were given theoretical knowledge in the first session and hands-on experience and practice were given in the second session. During the first session, thorough knowledge on various horticultural practices like cutting, budding, grafting and layering were given to the students and also about commercially important varieties, propagation structures, planting materials, cultivation packages etc. The second session in a more practically oriented manner where the students were given hands-on experience in using of the implements, cutting, budding, grafting and its types, layering and different other specialized propagation methods.

- Students developed skills in various propagation methods like cutting, budding, grafting, layering
- Familiarized with cultivation aspects of various crops
- Familiarized with important varieties
- Selection of good planting material
- Various propagation structures
- Mist, drip irrigation

2. Interacted and learnt the various varieties, field practices etc. of different crops available at RARS, Ambalavayal

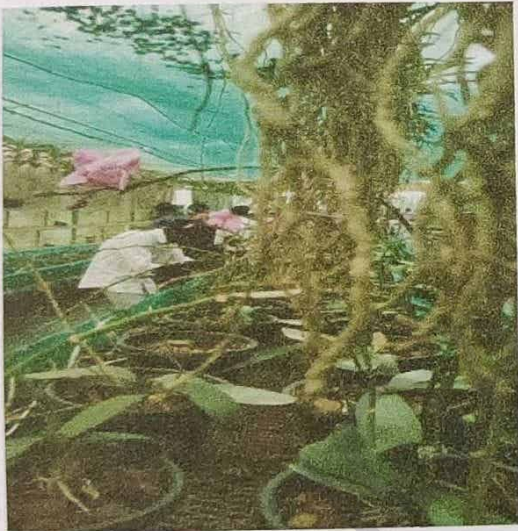
Regional Agricultural Research Station for High range zone is located at Ambalavayal, Wayanad district. The lead function of the station is to provide research support for agriculture in the High Range zone (Wayanad & Idukki districts and Nelliampathy area of Palakkad district). Cardamom Research Station, Pampadumpara, Idukki is a substation of RARS Ambalavayal. Research programmes on crop breeding and management aspects of pepper, ginger, rice, scented rice and cool season vegetables; studies on crop weather relationships, soil fertility management etc. are being undertaken. Research and infrastructure development programmes are funded by a number of agencies including Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), National Horticulture Mission (NHM), State Horticulture Mission (SHM), Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), India Meteorological department (IMD) and Government of Kerala. At present there are eleven state funded research/development projects and fourteen programmes supported by other agencies.

Fruit and Vegetable Processing Unit functioning under RARS, Ambalavayal utilizes the organically produced fruits and vegetables produced on the farm to make value added products like squashes, jams, pickles etc. while providing employment opportunity to 14 well-trained women self-help group members. Fruits like pineapple, guava, sapota, strawberry, papaya, passion fruit, mangosteen, litchi, mango etc. are routinely processed catering to the demands of local as well as distant markets. Seasonal fruits and vegetables are preserved as pulp and are hence available as products for purchase even during the off seasons. The seeds of the input materials used are collected separately and are processed to be sold or used for germination. Highly underused jackfruit has been demonstrated to be good

enough to be transformed into 101 value added products by the unit and has exhibited all of them in jack fests conducted during the past couple of years.

- k. Important varieties of major crops
- l. Tissue culture banana
- m. Propagation structures-mist house, green house, playhouse etc.
- n. Vegetable and fruit processing unit
- o. Product storage room
- p. Working principle of various food processing equipment
- q. Value added products and its packing and marketing (coffee powder, squash, wine, pickle, chips, oil etc.)

2. To interact with the farmers

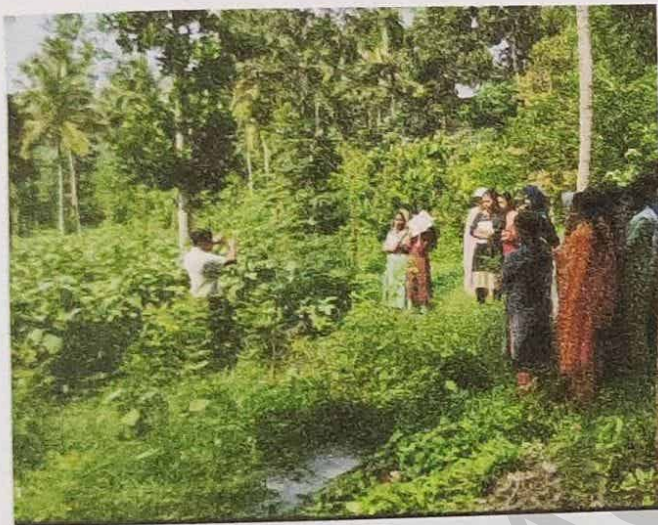
Outcomes of the visit






