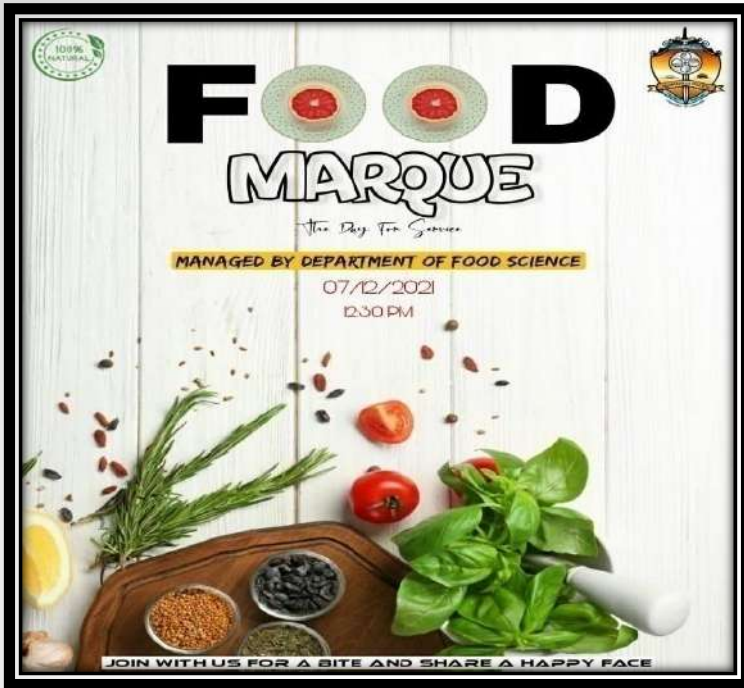

Cultivation of Crops

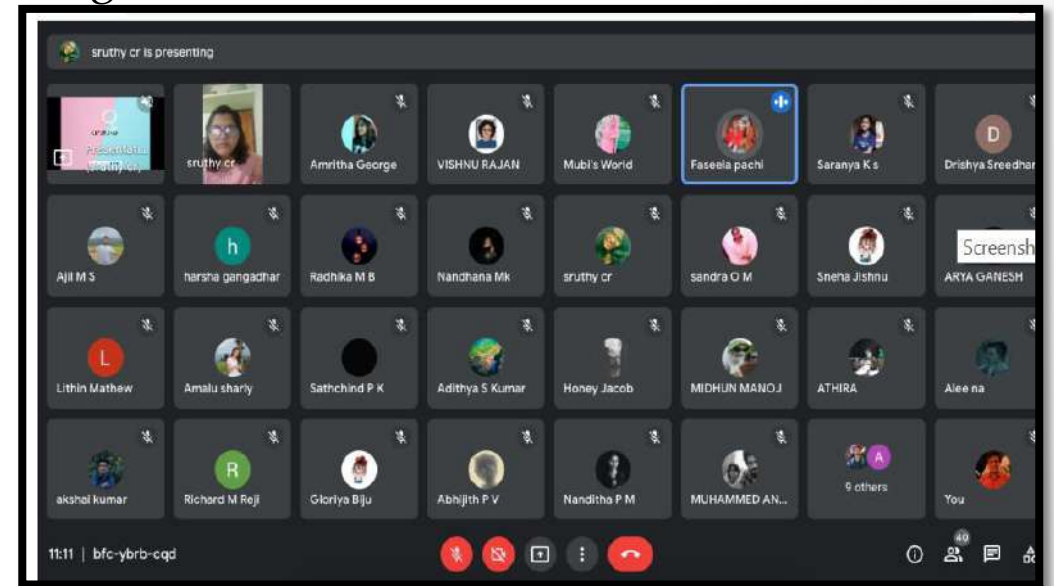
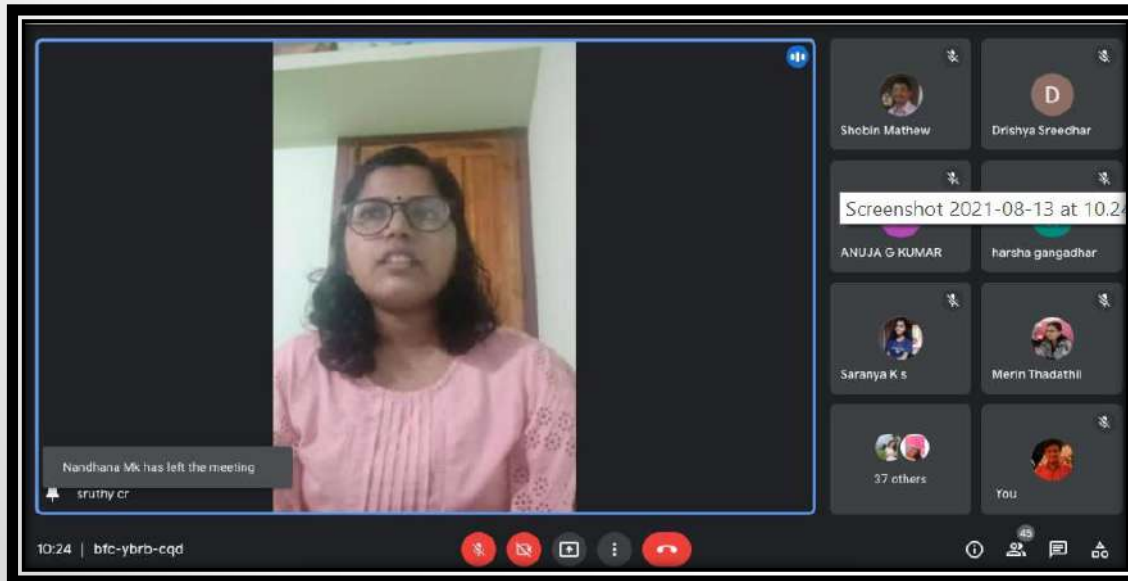

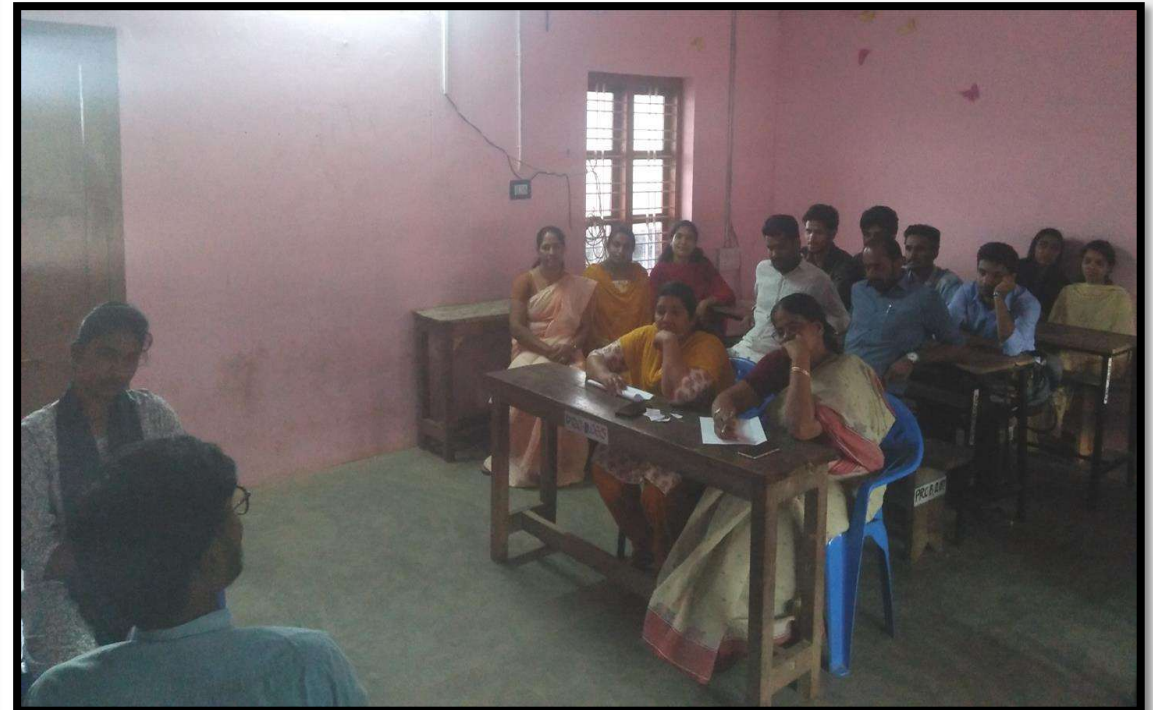

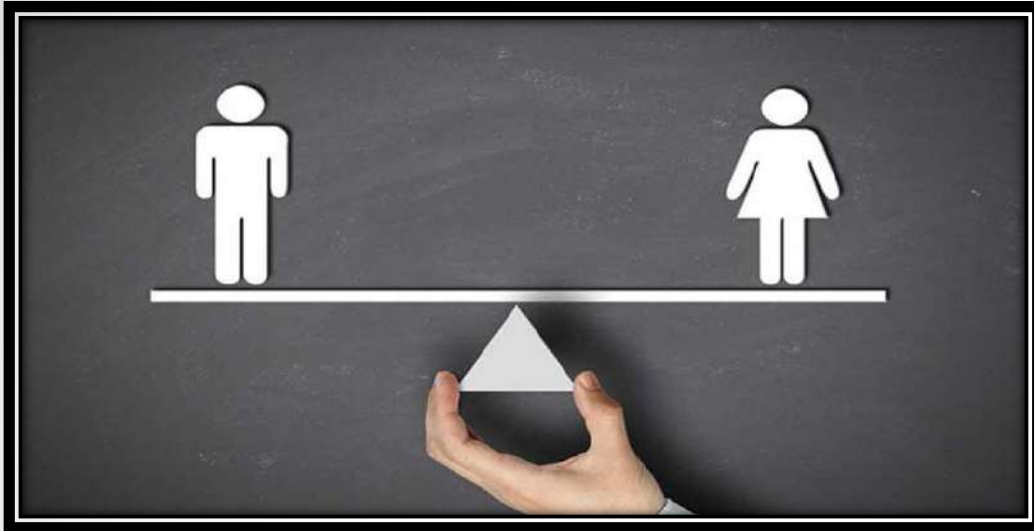
NSS Units (No. 071 & 153) of Pazhassiraja College, Pulpally celebrated *International Yoga Day*

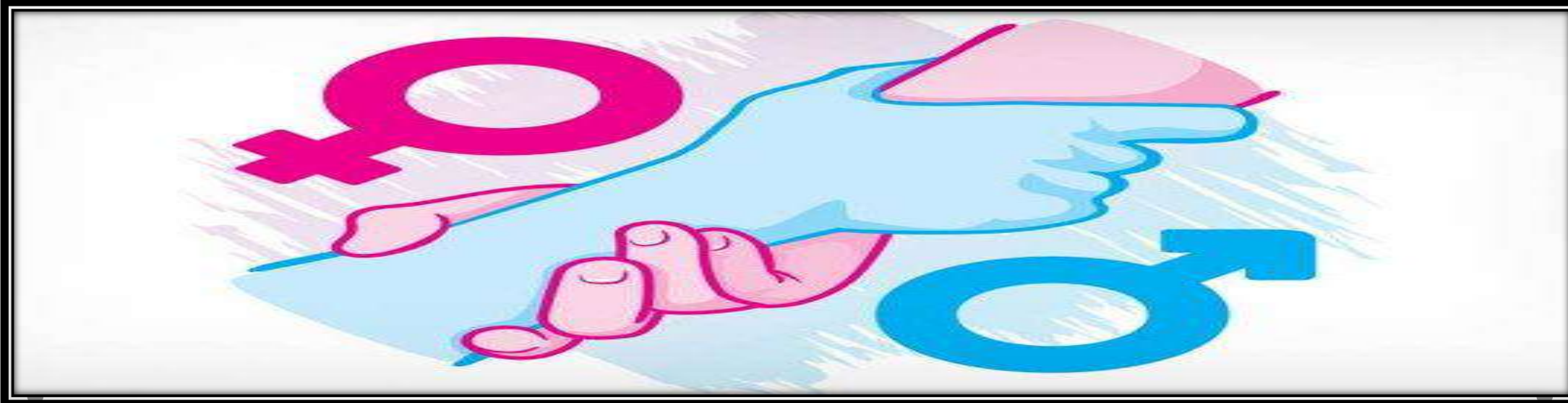
Cyber crime against women

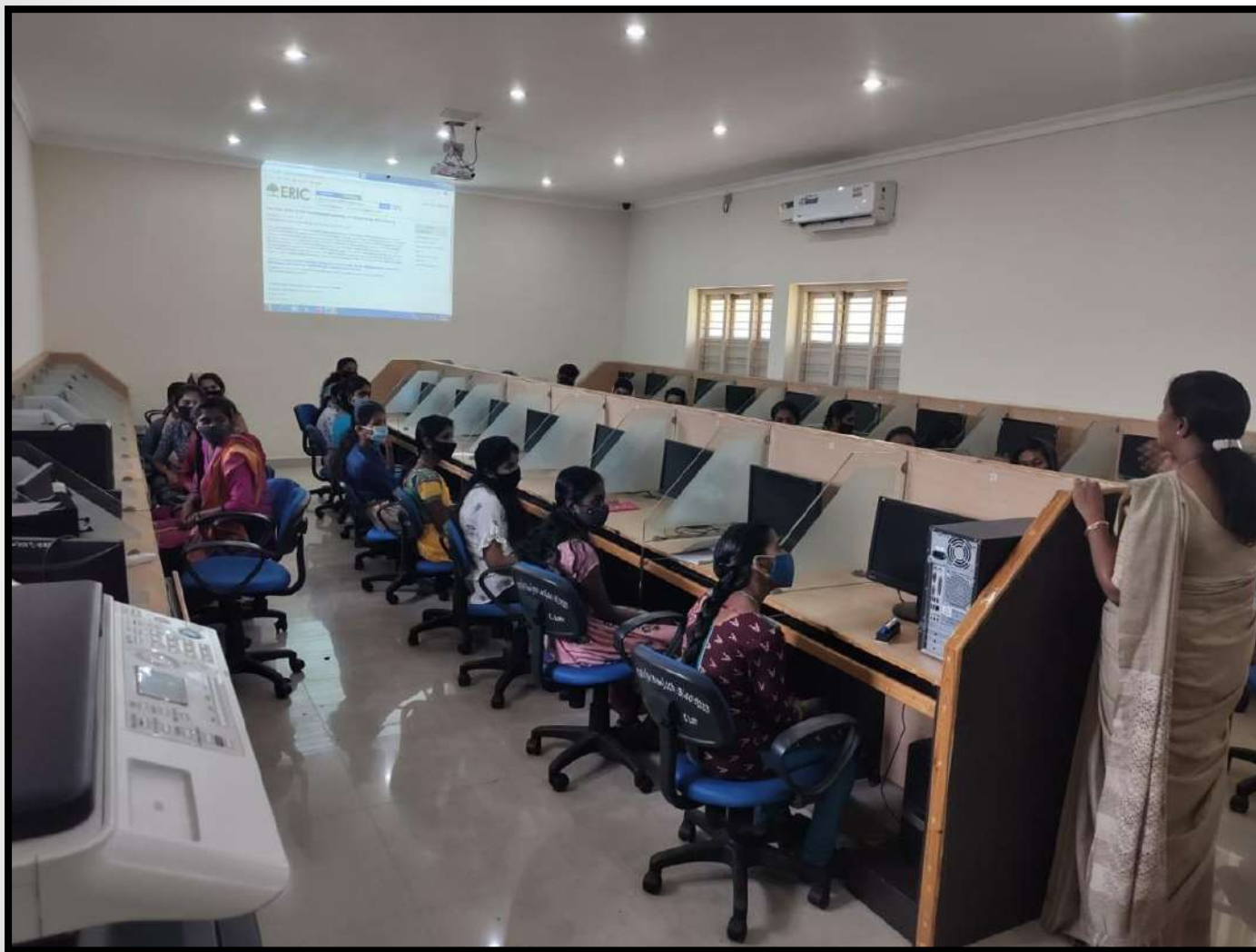


DEBATE ON WOMEN AND EMPLOYMENT

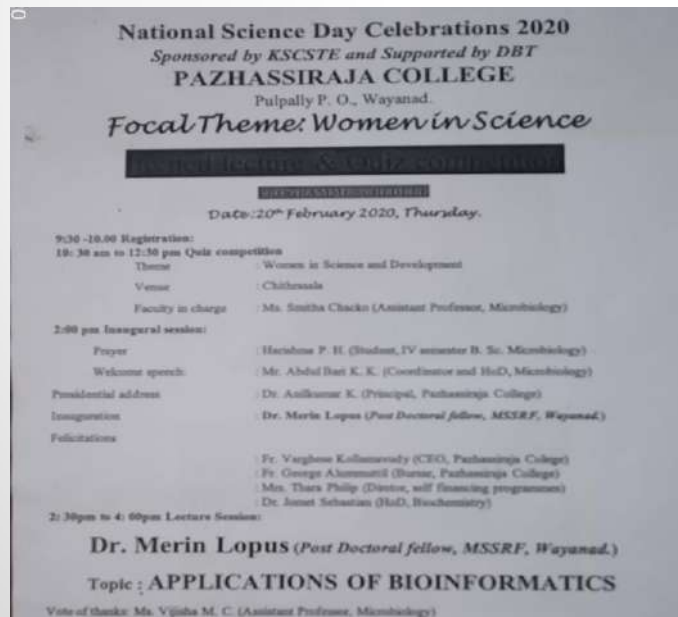
Body Literacy workshop
