Best Practice 1.

Awareness creation and solving agricultural problems of neighboring community through a programme titled "SAMRIDHI"

Objectives

This multi-dimensional programme was designed to equip the community around the college to be a model and to create awareness among the society about the need and significance of reclaiming the lost prosperity of Wayanad in the field of Agriculture. The following are the specific objectives.
