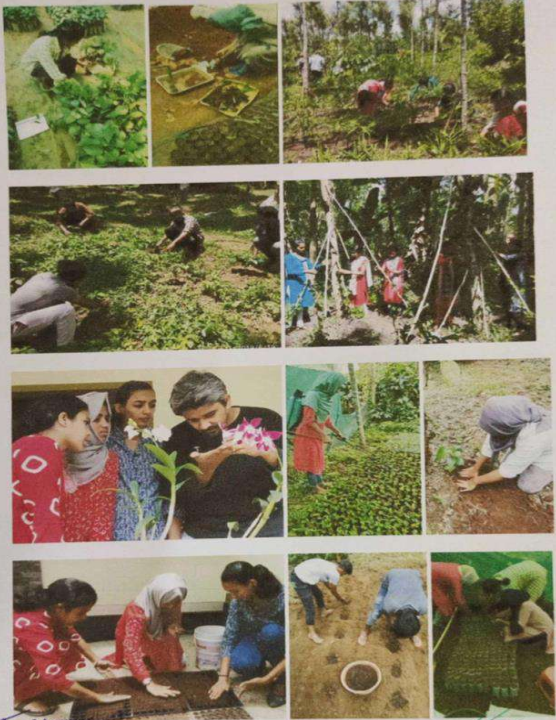

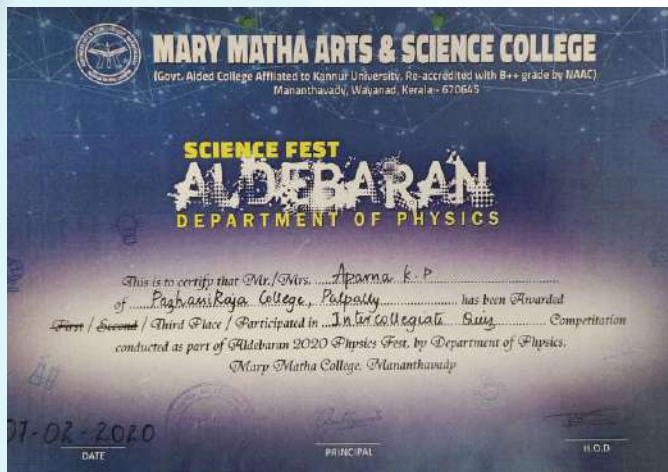

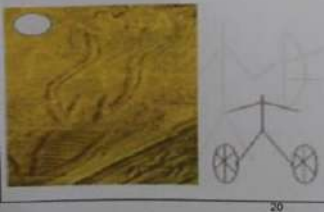

LIGHTNING OF HARAPPA ON ED

'Indian Antiquary' the official record of F. Fawcett Edakkal Caves. Since then world came to know about Edakkal. Studies were conducted about this pre-historic sites. The pioneers, Rajan Gurukkal, Jiravatham Mahadevan etc. are most of them. Dr. M.R. Rajagavawarier after a long term studies came to the conclusion that the picture of the Edakkal has certain similarities with some other

In 2010 archaeological survey of India officially unearthing Edakkal by removing layer of mud. These pictures has similarities with the image of a man standing on his knees, with his hands on his knees, drawn on the Indus seal collected from the Mohenjodaro on the same style. This may be regarded as accidental if was not for the Edakkal shown striking similarity with the drawing of the

One of the figure in Edakkal, which was unnoticed by Fawcett resembles ancient sun worship and named it 'sun worship' meaning its similarity with Indus table and signs could not be regarded as traditional style with only the local variations. Mayor had a Cuggal picture of Karnataka

The figure which has been repeated in many seals of Harappa has striking similarity with the seal figure of Mohenjodaro

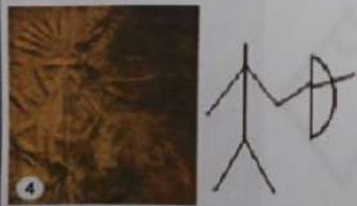
The picture depicting 3 people in a straight line should also be given. The left and right figures are the same to the figures seen in Edakkal, the only difference is the lines and marks on the body. The central one is erected with straight lines. Taller than the others and has four hands. This figure repeated in the Indus seals. Fawcett studied the Indus script scientifically, considered this figure as 'kadavul' or God

The Edakkal pictures were studied independently but no studies have been done to establish mutual relation and similarities between the pictures in the same sequence. It may indicate that similarity. Besides the human images certain other images are also present. May be the lines are indicating the name of the images standing left and right. The image on the left side and the animal images on the top also came to this series. This new meaning, which can be compared to the 'pasupati' seal of the Indus culture

The rock surface have been bayed damaged by visitors crude writings and engraving makes it very difficult to study the ancient modifies. There are two lotus flowers, one on the left (anagari) and many personal names in Roman letters, inscribed over the engravings.

ARATTUPARA

Arattupara which is situated between Meenangadi and Ambalavayal foot of the tourist placephantom rock in Wayanad. A megalithic burial site has been unearthed from Arattupara. The site was exposed during a clean-up drive organized by the national service scheme (NSS) unit of Government Higher Secondary School, Meenangadi. Two megalithic stone circles with cists were discovered by the student on a slope of the Arattupara hill during a weeklong camp here, under the leadership of NSS programme officer M.K Rajendran. There is five muniyaras, five of them two muniyaras were excavated but three of them not excavated. Two excavated muniyaras were existed with porch hole. One muniyara was constructed with stone bench. An iron spear, 1.5 meter long, pieces of iron knives, and pot shreds were found around the site. Huge boulders had used to form circles around the burial two of the burials had an unusual packing with stone and were in swastic formation.

These muniyaras are the most special and important one ever found on the land of Wayanad. Huge stoneslabs are used for the megalithic construction. An old spear, iron pieces of 30 cm the broken pieces of pots, a piece of metal plate etc. were found from these muniyaras. This discovered items were handed over to the Tahasildar of SulthanBathery Mr Abraham.

Agriculture**, to provide more practical knowledge to the students of 2018 and 2019 batch (semester I and semester III), regarding the cultivation of crops at field level, they were taken for a case analysis with a progressive farmer on 13th August, 2019. Sri. Joseph Pallan was chosen for the study who has been a farmer for the past 28 years. In 1993, he retired from Indian Army and started betel cultivation in 40 cents. From 1994-2006 he was following conventional method of cultivation and in 2007 he was recognized as a progressive farmer. From 2008-2011 he concentrated more on open precision farming (Micro irrigation, plastic mulching) and in 2012 he started relay and open precision farming. He has prepared a crop calendar of his own based on which the cultivation practices are carried out. Besides, various innovative ideas of Mr. Pallan are relay cropping (six crops are cultivated), two in one trap (pheromone trap and yellow sticky trap), Bhindi planted in rows are slanted one over the other and cow pea trailed over it, prevents wind break. He has a total of 40 acres of land but owned land is only 3 acres which includes home and garden in 6 cents and farmstead in 2.94 acres. Rest 37 acres are leased land.

Various plant protection measures adopt are, pheromone traps for the control of fruit fly-placed throughout the crop, yellow for the control of sucking pest @ 4 nos./acre, if severe, new generation chemic labelled) are used, neem based pesticides are used (*Azadirachtin* 2%) against such fish amino acid is used for the control of sucking pest, trap crop like marigold along the sides of bunds, rice is cultivated in a row in the field in order to attract. Considering the water management, drip irrigation is given on a daily basis for 1 h drips are established) and the irrigation is scheduled according to the type of moisture conservation, mulching is carried out where the beds are covered with sheets of 30µ thickness (silver color outside and black inside).

His future plans are establishment of a vermicompost unit and aquaponics. Accordi soil must be given foremost importance while starting any farming activity. T should have genuine interest in farming. Plants need to be given proper care. Farm made profitable only with constant hard work and dedication.

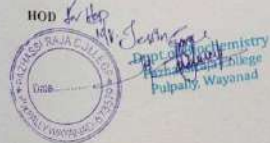
REPORT ON STUDENT AS TEACHER 2019-2020

EDAKKAL: THE ROCK MAGIC

Twenty five kilometers away from Kalpetta lays two caves which showcases nature's skill and philosophy on architecture. These caves are located 1,200 m above the sea level on Ambukutty Mala. The name 'Edakkal' literally means 'a stone in between'. Here you can see a cave formed by a heavy boulder straddling a fissure in the rock. Many legends are there behind the formation of Edakkal caves. One of the stories is that, these caves are said to be formed with the arrows fired by Lava and Kusha, the sons of Lord Sri Rama. Another one is associated with Kunti Chathan and the Goddess Mudiampilly. The local people used to have a pilgrimage trip to this place to honour the Goddess.

The caves were discovered by Fred Fawcett, the then Superintendent of Police of the Malabar district in 1890, during his hunting trip to Wayanad. He discovered the Edakkal rock-shelter, situated on the western side of Edakkalmala. To his surprise, he identified the place as a habitat of Neolithic people.

Edakkal caves are famous for its pictorial paintings (cave paintings), which are considered to be of 6000 B.C. To reach the caves, one has to trek through the Ambukutty Mala. It will take around 45 minutes to climb the hill and you will never get disappointed in your trip to these historic caves.

Inside the cave, you can see two chambers. The lower chamber is 18 ft long, 12 ft wide and 10 ft high and the upper chamber is 96 ft long, 22 ft wide and 18 ft high. You can sight carvings of human, animal figures and objects used by humans, on the walls of the caves. These carvings give great evidence for a highly civilized society who lived in the pre-historic age. Edakkal caves have drawn great attention of archeologists and historians worldwide.

Edakkal is the only known place in India with Stone Age carvings. You can see here carvings belonging to Neolithic and Mesolithic age. The human figures of these caves have raised hair and some have masks. They all have archeological significance and are interesting too. Along with these pictorial carvings, you can also watch Tamil and Brahmī Script in Edakkal caves.

Edakkal is said to have some links with Indus Valley Civilization too. Around 400 signs were discovered recently, which had shown its relationship with the ancient civilization. The prominent among them was 'a man with a jar cup'.

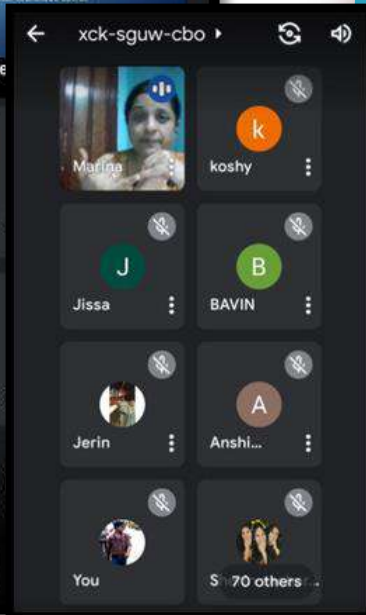
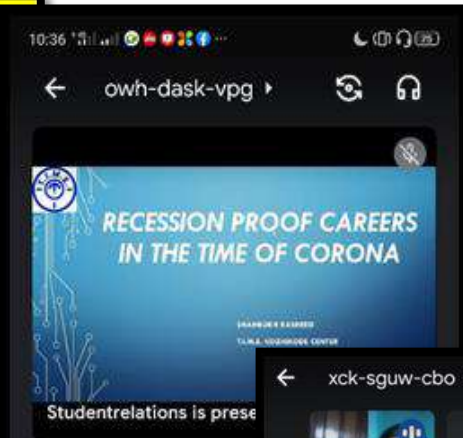

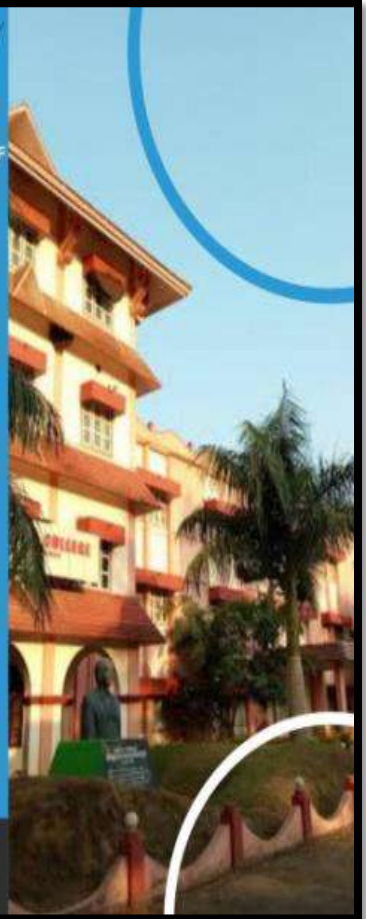
