
Place of visit: Pasteur Institute, Coonor, Ooty



ARATTUPARA

Aramupara which is situated between Meerangadi and Ambalayayal foot of thetourist slacephantom rock in Wayanad A megalithic borial site has been mearthed from Arattupara. The site was exposed during a clean-up drive organized by the national service scheme (NSS) unit of Government Higher Secondary School Meenangadi . Two megalithic stone circles with cists were discovered by the student on a slope of the Arattopara hill during a weeklong camp here, under the leadership of NSS programme officer M.K. Rajendran. There is five muniyarus. five of them two minivariis were excavated but three of them not excavated. Two excavated muniyaras were existed with porth hole. One muniyara was constructed with stone bench. An iron spear , 1.5 meter long, pieces of iron knives , and pot shreds were found around the site. Huge boulders had used to from circles around the burial two of the burials had an unusual packing with stone and were in awastic formation.

These muniyarus are the most special and important one ever found on the land of Wayanad Huge stonesslabs are used for the megaliths construction. An old spear, aron piece of 30 cm the broken pieces of pots, a piece of metal plate etc. were found from these muniyarras. This discovered items were handed over to the Tahasildar of SulthanBathery Mr

CASE ANALYSIS 2

As part of the course, B.Vec. Agriculture, to provide more practical knowledge to the students of 2018 and 2019 batch (semester I and semester III), regarding the cultivation of crops at field level, they were taken for a case analysis with a progressive farmer on 13th August, 2019. Sri. Joseph Pallan was chosen for the study who has been a farmer for the past 28 years. In 1993, he retired from Indian Army and started betel cultivation in 40 cents. From 1994-2006 he was following conventional method of cultivation and in 2007 he was recognized as a progressive farmer. From 2008-2011 he concentrated more on open precision farming (Micro irrigation, plastic mulching) and in 2012 he started relay and open precision farming. He has prepared a crop calendar of his own based on which the cultivation practices are carried out. Besides, various innovative ideas of Mr. Pallan are relay cropping (six crops are cultivated), two in one trap (pheromone trap and yellow sticky trap), Bhindi planted in rows are slanted one over the other and cow pea trailed over it, prevents wind break. He has a total of 40 acres of land but owned land is only 3 acres which includes home and garden in 6 cents and farmstead in 2.94 acres. Rest 37 acres are leased land.

Plants need to be given proper care. Farm made profitable only with constant hard work and dedication.

EDAKKAL: THE ROCK MAGIC

Twenty five kilometers away from Kalpetta lays two caves which showcases nature's skill and philosophy on architecture. These caves are located 1,200 m above the sea level on Ambukutty Mala. The name 'Edakkal' literally means 'a stone in between'. Here you can see a cave formed by a heavy boulder straddling a fissure in the rock.

Many legends are there behind the formation of Edakkul caves. One of the stories is that, these caves are said to be formed with the arrows fred by Lava and Kusha, the sons of Lord Sri Rama. Another one is associated with Kurti Chathan and the Goddess Mudiampilly. The local people used to have a pilgrimage trip to this place to honour the Goddess.

The cases were discovered by Fred Fawcett, the then Superintendent of Police of the Malahar district in 1890, during his hunting trip to Wayanad. He discovered the Edakkal rocksheher, situated on the western side of Edakkalmata. To his surprise, he identified the place as a habitat of Neokolshie people.

Edukkal caves are famous for its pictorial paintings (cave paintings), which are considered to be of 6000 B C. To reach the caves, one has to trek through the Ambukutty Mala. It will take around 45 minutes to climb the hill and you will never get disappointed in your trip to these historic caves.

Inside the cave, you can see two chambers. The lower chamber is 18 ft long, 12 ft wide and 10 ft high and the upper chamber is 96 ft long, 22 ft wide and 18 ft high. You can sight carvings of human, animal figures and objects used by humans, on the walls of the caves. These carvings give great evidence for a highly civilized society who lived in the pre-historic age. Edakkal caves have drawn great attention of archeologists and historians worldwide.


Edakkal is the only known place in India with Stone Age carvings. You can see here carvings belonging to Neolithic and Mesolithic age. The human figures of these caves have raised harr and some have masks. They all have archeological significance and are interesting too. Along with these pictorial carvings, you can also watch Tamil and Brahmi Script in Edakkal caves.

Edakkal is said to have some links with Indus Valley Civilization too. Around 400 signs were discovered recently, which had shown its relationship with the ancient civilization. The prominent among them was 'a man with a jar cup'.



















