




World Computer Literacy Day (02-12-2021)


Environmental Day Celebration – 05th June 2021


Activities of 11th December 2021 to 10th January 2022

• As part of seven days NSS special camp, first year volunteers have cleaned the campus and surrounding areas. 107 first year volunteers have participated in the cleaning activity.




• On 27/12/2021 an exercise session lead by the senior NSS Volunteers Abin Thankachan and Rehan Benny.




 On 31/12/2021 Mr. Sanoopkumar P V conducted an interactive games session at chithrashala.

Invited Lecture



2021 - 22 READING DAY CELEBRATION


