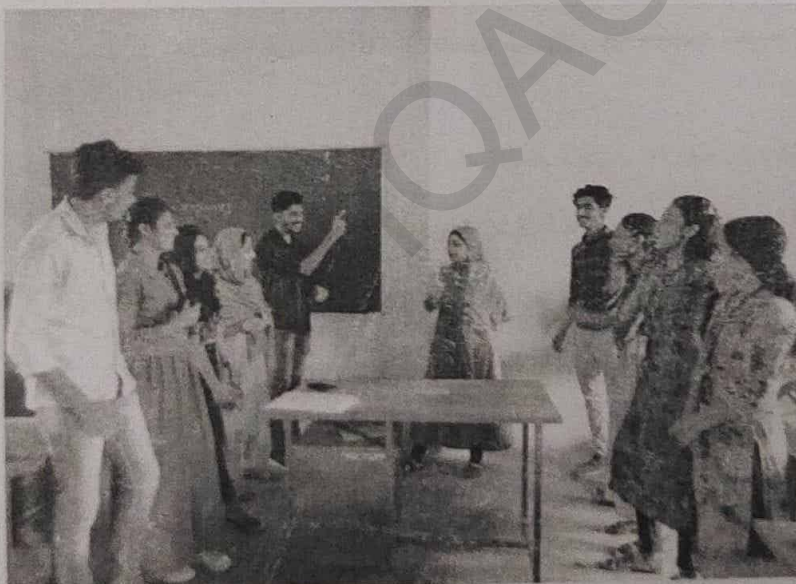
INTER HOUSE DEBATE COMPETITION-2019

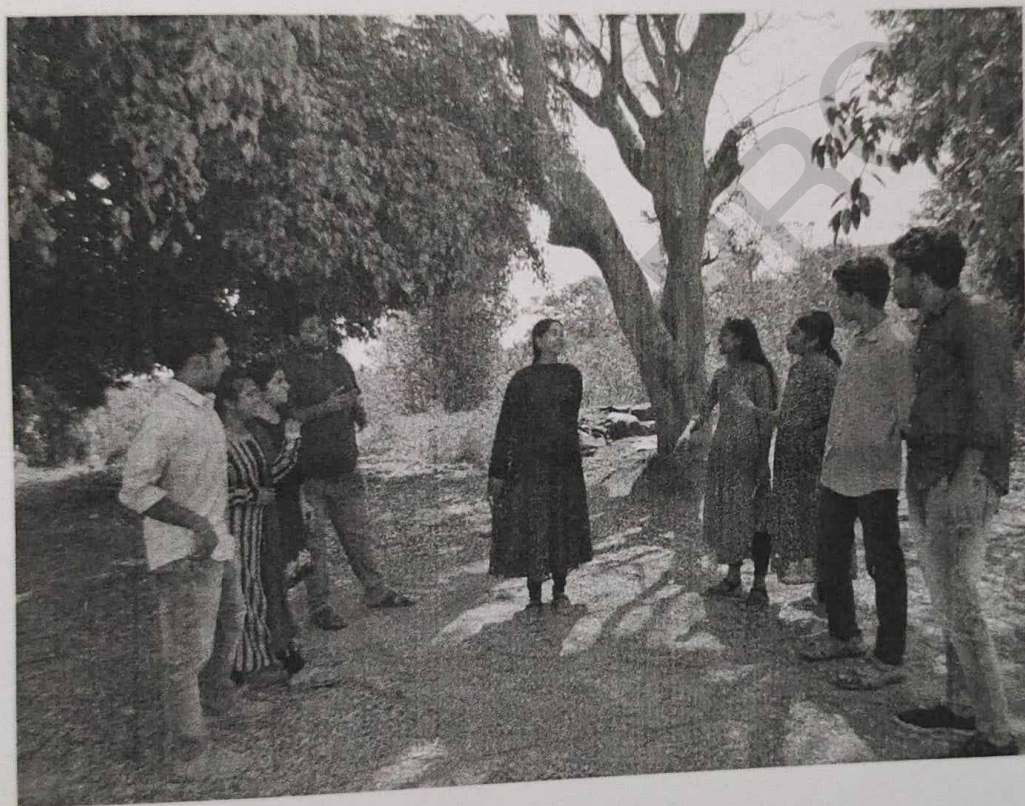

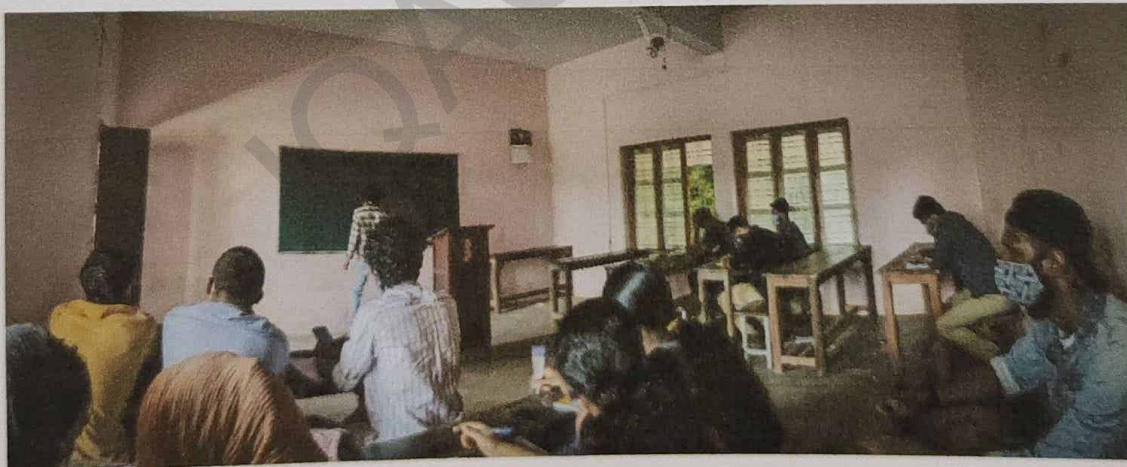
For organic crops

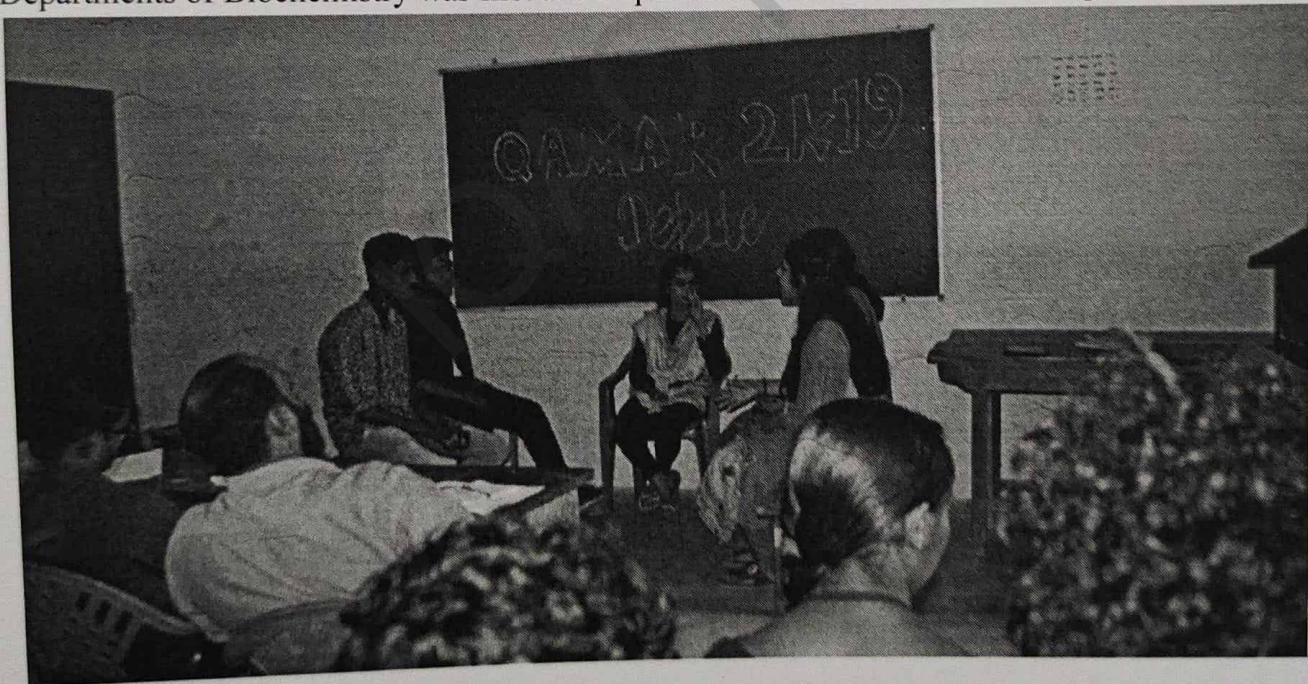
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


Images of winners in quiz and collage making competitions

Departments of Biochemistry was first and Department of mass communication got 2nd.

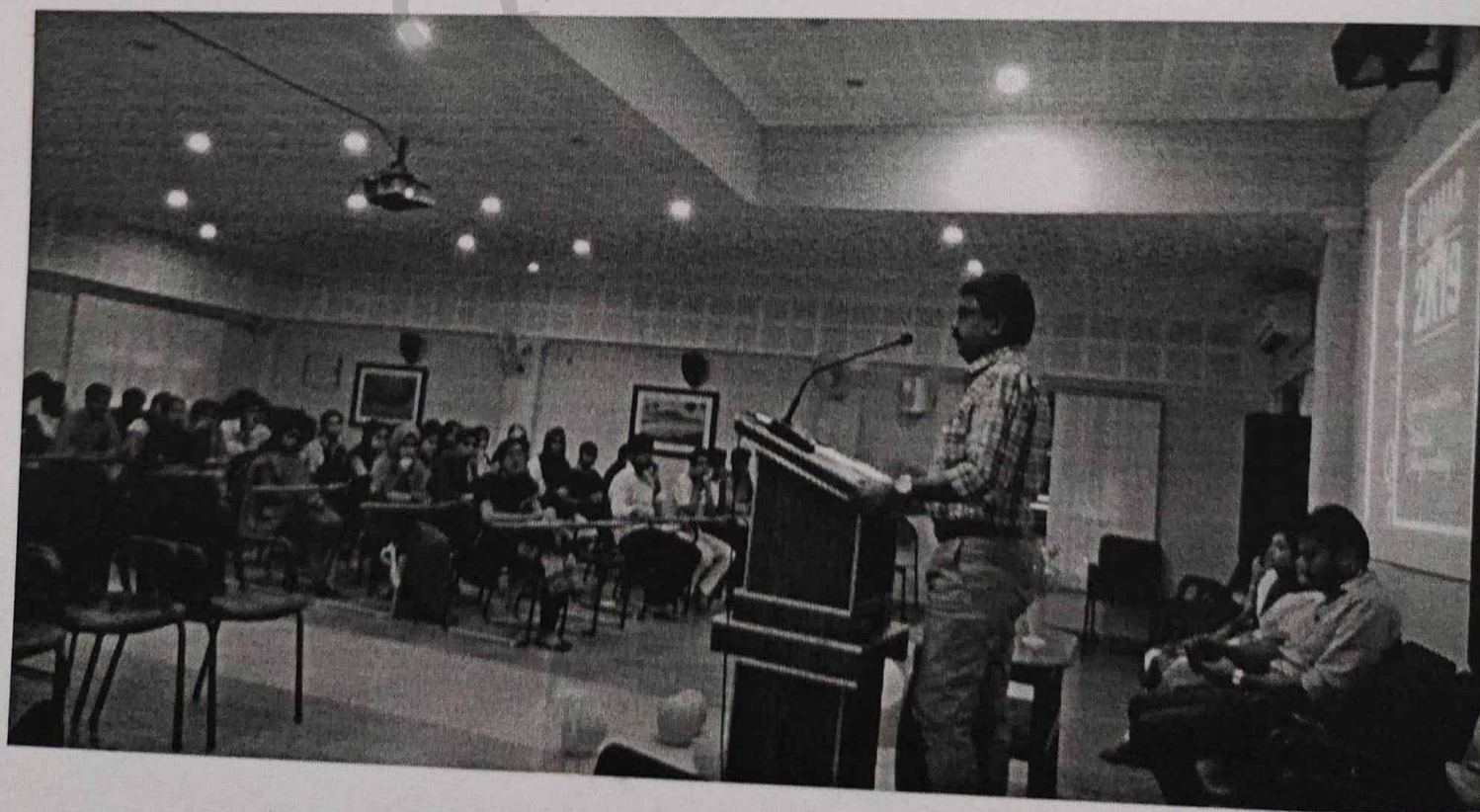

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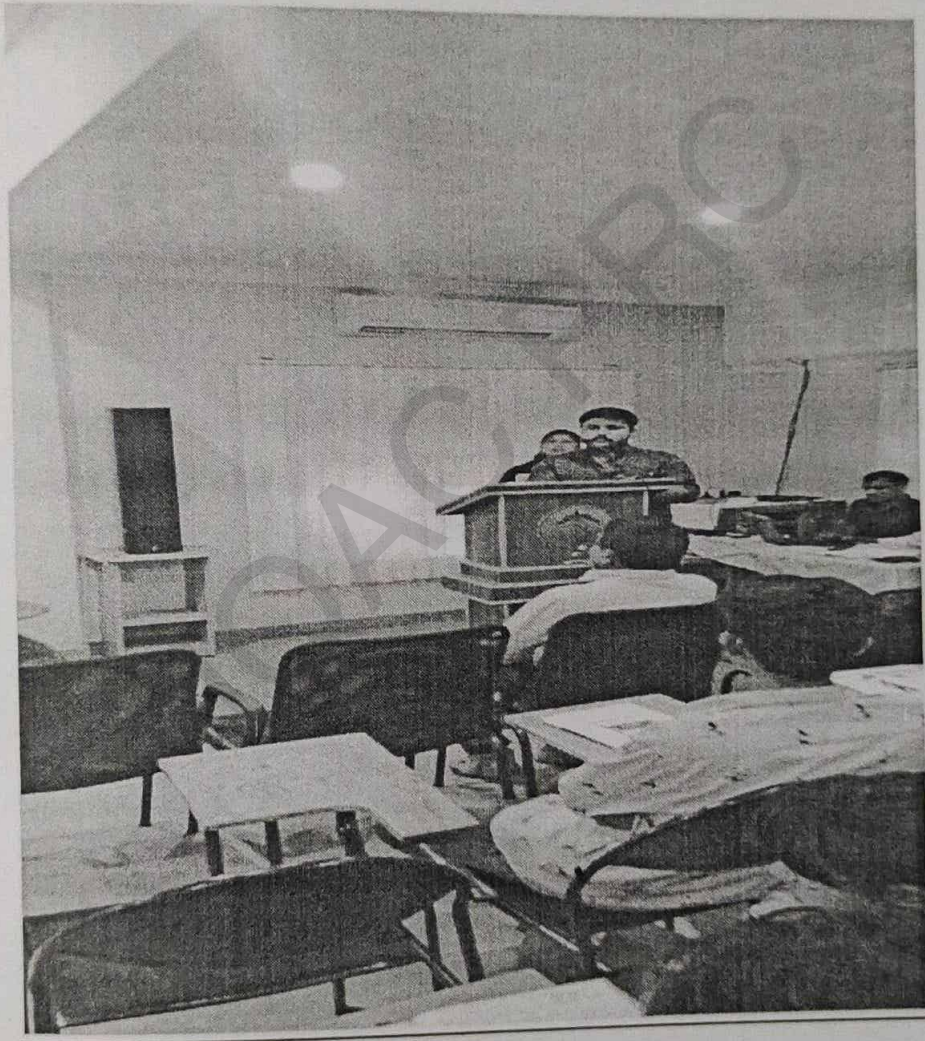
Winners of collage making competition
