
- a. Training small trees


1. To get familiarize with the cultivation practices of different vegetables

An area of 1 acre was identified by the students for vegetable cultivation. The cultivation of different vegetables was under the Kerala Government Scheme 'Jeevani 2019-20' which was for institutional garden. The students cultivated various crops like bitter gourd, ivy gourd, tomato, chilli, brinjal, cowpea, cabbage, bhindi and amaranthus under the guidance of the Department of Vocational Studies (Agriculture) and Kerala Agricultural Development and Farmers Welfare department. The students get acquainted with different farm practices *viz*;






